All As One was founded in 1997, and we have been working in Sierra Leone since 2000. Our work began in the midst of a brutal civil war, and we have now seen the country begin a post-war recovery. **Although recovery is happening, there is still much to be done.** With this in mind, we've recently re-visited All As One's purpose (mission) and vision for Sierra Leone, and have now revised our mission and vision statements. I'm happy to share them with you here:

MISSION:


Providing Sierra Leone's children and women with education, health care and other basic needs – empowering them to develop a healthy nation.

VISION:

A strong and self-reliant Sierra Leone.

Notice that part of our primary mission focus is education. **Currently the adult literacy rate in Sierra Leone is 30%. This means that 70% of the population cannot read or write.** All As One believes this is an unacceptable statistic – and we're doing our part to change it, one child at a time.

Pictured here is Kelly, age 8. Kelly was on the course to becoming another statistic in illiteracy until he came to live at the Children's Center. Although Kelly had never attended school, he's now a pupil in the All As One accredited school, and is doing extremely well in his studies.



He has shown a great aptitude for learning and is a very bright little boy. We're thrilled that we can help Kelly start to reach his potential...and help to change one more child's life for the better. It's what makes this work worth doing!
