will be famous! He is the Guardian of the Animals.


The true King of the Jungle!

How many Quiz-Off questions did you get right? Check your answers here! First, the three stages of a cockroach's life cycle are egg, nymph and adult cockroach. Not yucky, gross and disgusting! Second, guppies are different from other fish because they give birth to live young instead of laying eggs. Danny got that part right but wrongly assumed they were mammals! Finally, a platypus is a mammal. Unlike other mammals, it lays eggs instead of giving birth to live young so it's quite an odd mammal indeed.

An animal becomes extinct when every single one of its kind dies off. Sadly, quite a few magnificent creatures have become extinct, such as the Pyrenean ibex (a type of wild goat). Others are 'endangered', meaning they are in danger of becoming extinct. When we cut down trees, many animals lose their forest homes. Cars and factories release greenhouse gases, causing global warming which affects animals living in colder environments, such as polar bears. It doesn't help that humans often hunt endangered animals, reducing their numbers even further.

You may be thrilled to know that driverless cars like the Hover Cabs already exist in our time! In Singapore, driverless vehicles are being tested out, such as at Gardens by the Bay. Many people are excited about driverless cars because they're guided by technology and are safer on the roads (they automatically stop when they sense someone in front of them, for example).

We imagined a Singapore free of cockroaches and like Danny, you might be cheering! However, this is unlikely to happen. Insects are incredibly adaptable and evolve quickly to suit their new homes. Danny also doesn't realise that insects play a very important role in the animal world. They serve as food for other animals like birds and lizards. They also help pollinate our plants. Without insects such as the humble honeybee, we would lose 50% of all the fruits and veggies we eat (as well as the honey!)

Genetically modifying people may sound like a creepy idea but it actually exists today. Scientists have found a way to tweak the genes of a baby before it's formed by cutting out DNA sequences and replacing them with new ones. These babies are known as "designer babies". Currently, this process is mostly used to eliminate genetic diseases and ensure healthy babies, but we're imagining a future where parents would be able to pay for a smart, pretty, sporty or even "perfect" baby.

MAA! Ever heard of Dolly the Sheep? Dolly became famous for being the first mammal to be cloned. Cloning is when scientists make an exact copy of an organism's DNA. It's like creating an identical twin! Looking at your clone would be like looking at your own reflection in a mirror. At the moment, cloning works best from live cells but scientists are working on ways to clone animals from frozen, dead cells.
