Humber Pullman Limousine - Black/Burgundy (Baroness Rothschild)

Another highly detailed luxury car joins the Oxford series of 1:43 scale motors of an opulent bygone age. The first release on the newly tooled Humber Pullman was - in real life - owned by Baroness Rothschild. It is now in the Humber Car Museum owned by Allan Marshall, who allowed the Oxford team to research the intricate internal and external detail to produce the master model.

Our newly tooled Humber Pullman is a superb miniature. Starting with the exterior, the black and burgundy two-tone paintwork is offset by a wealth of silver chrome effect masking from the radiator, headlights, door handles and rear light clusters to the authentic replica of the

Pullman badge. The Humber badge is masked in red out of silver and the Rothschild crest adorns the front doors. We love the whitewall tyres, which complement the contrasting burgundy wheel inserts.

Inside, the detail is even more amazing. In the front, the dashboard top and the steering wheel are reproduced in 'sunshine' beige with a detailed dashboard and door cappings in brown. The floor/carpets and front seats are a rich burgundy colour. Behind the interior dividing screen, which separated the chauffeur from the rear passenger area, the colour scheme is a rich cream used for the seats, floor/carpets and the door panels, with the door cappings finished in brown.

Volvo FH Livestock Lorry - Fred Greenwood & Sons of Esholt

Oxford's Volvo FH will also be available with a rigid curbside and box body and its versatility has also enabled us to introduce a brand new Livestock unit. For the first release off the new tool, we've chosen the highly decorative and brightly coloured Fred Greenwood livery.

The company operates out of the small village of Esholt in West Yorkshire with a fleet of livestock lorries, including this one.

Our Oxford replica is registered GN03 EXS. It has a six-wheel configuration. The eye-catching bodywork of bright red and cream comes with a red roof and black chassis. It also has another thirteen printed colours to make up the authentic decoration of the original. The model features the additional components of four grille-mounted spotlights and four roof-mounted spotlights. The cab features a wealth of minute and colourful detail, which even extends to a black tinted sun visor. On the rear

VW T25 Van - Pastel White

Brand new Oxford tooling brings enthusiasts the very versatile Volkswagen T25 three-door, rear engine Van, which during its life lent itself to a great variety of uses, two more of which are also the subjects of Oxford models this month.

The German manufactured vehicle was known as the VW Transporter or VW Caravelle (T3) in Europe, whilst in the UK it went under the VW T25 title. Assembled in Hanover, it had a production life from 1979 to 1992 – and until 2002 in South Africa, when it was superseded by the VW Transporter (T4).

Our new model, registered CBW 425V which dates from 1979, is decorated in the authentic pastel white of the original with detailing that includes black window surrounds, wipers, door handles, bumpers, petrol filler cap and side rear air vents. The VW logo features on the radiator and the Volkswagen Transporter lettering also features across the back. Note too, the detailed light clusters and silver wheel inserts, all adding to an authentic replica of the real life vehicle.

VW T25 Van - Cornat Blue/Guinea Blue

This second release on the VW T25 comes in the shape of a Mini Bus as manufactured in 1983, registered A387 BVO. Striking in its simplicity, it is presented with an eye-catching bright blue body with contrasting lighter blue roof. The Mini Bus was a popular variant of the T25, with passengers using the sliding side door to access the rowed seating. The additional masking details on the Mini Bus are similar to our newly introduced Van version of the VW T25, featuring lots of black and silver trim.

New tooling brings you another superb modern Police vehicle to add to your Emergency Services collection. The Land Rover Discovery 3, as used by the Essex Police, carries the familiar yellow and blue chequered livery on a black lower body with dark blue roof, complete with roof light bars and highly visible red and yellow markings across the rear of the vehicle. So that it can be seen from the air, the roof is also decorated with its authentic identity number. The model features the registration plate EU07JUA, as used by the Traffic section of the Essex Police authorities since 2007. The fine details on this latest introduction include intricate masking on the window surrounds, door handles, roof/rear and side trim, front grille and bumpers. The advanced printing techniques also ensure the finely accurate reproduction of the Essex Police badge on the bonnet and on the side rear windows.

Land Rover Discovery - Zermatt Silver

The second release on the contemporary Land Rover Discovery is presented in elegant Zermatt Silver with black chassis and black exterior features. The interior is also black. Registered HN07 DJU, the radiator grille has the added detail of the Land Rover badge in green, also repeated above the rear number plate. Tiny additional features include the rear lights printed in orange and red. Note too the Discovery 3 wording underneath the rear number plate as well as the TDV6 HSE printed on the offside rear. Now that's attention to detail!

Gloster Meteor plus Doodle Bug

The Gloster Meteor was the first British jet and the Allies' first operational jet fighter during WWII. The Meteor F1 first flew in 1943 and commenced operations in July 1944 with 616 Squadron, RAF. The Meteor proved very successful and one of its key roles was to counter the V-1 Flying Bomb (the Doodlebug) which the Luftwaffe were directing towards London and south east England. Our Gloster Meteor is a model of the F3 variant of 616 Squadron, as flown in 1945. It is decorated in the grey and green camouflage scheme, RAF markings and grey underside.

To complement it, the Meteor comes with its lethal adversary - the Doodlebug. The German - V-1 flying bomb - known officially as the Fiesler Fi 103 pilotless flying bomb - was first launched in June 1944 and at its height, more than a hundred a day were dropping over the SE corner of England.

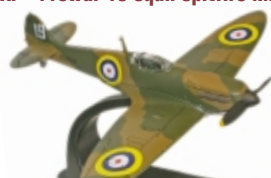

DH Dragon Rapide - Prince of Wales/King Edward VIII

The De Havilland Dragon Rapide was designed by De Havilland in late 1933 and was intended for use as a British short-haul passenger airliner during the 1930s. Taking its first flight in 1934 and entering service with Hillman Airways, the twin engine aircraft with its tapered wings, streamlined fairings, speed and comfort, was probably the most successful British short haul commercial passenger plane of the 1930s. Throughout its life, over 700 were built, a third of which were used by civil airlines. This particular aircraft, however, had Royal patronage.

The Royal family has used air transport for Royal visits since the 1930s. King Edward VIII became the first British monarch to fly in 1936. Royal flight was formalised on 21st July 1936 with the creation of the King's Flight at Hendon, North London. The new Flight operated a single twin-engine Dragon Rapide – G-ADDD, which had formerly been HRH King Edward VIII's private aircraft. It is this model that we have chosen as only the second release off the new 1:72 scale tool. Resplendent in blue, red and silver, note particularly the Prince of Wales' Feathers in minute detail on the tail.

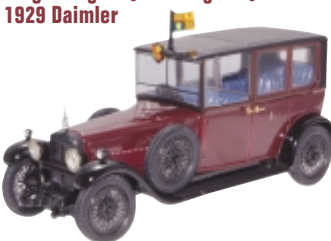

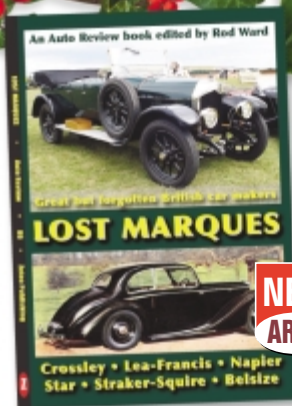

AR86 Lost Marques

In this publication we tell the stories of six great British car marques. None of these marques was absorbed by another car maker, so the tales told here are unlike many others we have covered in the Auto Review series. In fact, most of these car marques were only 'lost' when the owners voluntarily gave up car-making in order to pursue other activities. After abandoning car production, Napier concentrated on aero engines and Lea-Francis turned to general engineering. Crossley was taken over by AEC, and Star by Guy, both commercial vehicle manufacturers. Straker-Squire, whose designs formed the core of Bristol aero engines closed after the founder died in an accident.
