The Southdown bus fleet's familiar green and cream livery, one of the most instantly recognised in its time, is much loved by collectors today and will no doubt be snapped up by bus enthusiasts eager to extend their Southdown bus depots. The destination board sees this bus heading for Hayling Island whilst the separate side boards advertise Hire Southdown for your Private Party. Registered LUF 640 with black chassis, interior detail

includes a black steering wheel and brown seating. The Southdown logo along the side, reproduced in gold with black dropped shadow and silver masking, makes a great contrast to the green body colour.

The wheel inserts are also green with silver masking. With this great livery, our Leyland Royal Tiger is bound to be very popular.

AEC Matador Wrecker - Southdown

The AEC Matador Wrecker, used extensively as a WWII workhorse, found its way into the ownership of many commercial operators in civilian life. Southdown may have used the vehicle for 'rescuing' broken down buses and coaches from their fleet. Decorated here in the characteristic green and cream of this popular south coast company, the truck is registered ING 641 and also features the red and white trade plate 340 PX and 'towing' plate. The flatbed planking is

painted brown, housing the crane and towing hook, all ready for action.

Tricycle Van - Gas and Coke Service

Dating from the 1930s, the Tricycle Van was seen on general service duties right into the 1950s. This unusual livery advertising its use as a Gas and Coke Service van is in bright red and a vanilla cream colour, simply decorated with a flaming beacon on the sides. Masked silver porthole windows feature on the back doors and additional relief comes with the black mudguards, chassis and front window

pillars. The van is registered FXW 983 and has a single light above the front wheel.




Scania Highline Horsebox - Metallic Champagne

along the top of the roof and finite details include the tinted black back rear side windows and satin black tinted window frames. Registered E7 ENT, the back doors carry the wording Horses also written in German - Pferde and French - Chevaux, indicating perhaps it is used for international transport of our equine friends.

Dennis RS Fire Engine - Dublin Auxiliary Fire Service

The newly tooled Oxford 1:76 scale version of the Dennis RS was launched in Issue 159. The second release sees the model in the distinctive Irish Civil Defence livery as used by the Dublin Auxiliary Fire Service. In real life, this purpose built fire appliance with reinforced all-steel cab was introduced and used extensively in the late 1970s and although production ceased in the 1990s, you can still see the RS in use today by some fire authorities.

Our colourful model is very high on detail with a wealth of equally decorative masking operations, making for a realistic replica. Note the fine black lines etched into the shutters, the masked hose reels, the rear chevron detail and the AFS crest on the sides, all creating extra realism.

The VW T25 dating from the 1980s came in a variety of colour schemes and this latest Oxford model, registered CGH 866T, is painted in pale creamy yellow and comes with the joker high-top roof with Joker logo. Black masking has been applied to the ventilation louvres, door handles with other details picked out in silver. The Westphalia

branding features across the back of the roof in black, whilst the other VW logos are masked in silver.

VW T25 Bus - Lime Green/Saima Green

An eye-catching green body with light green roof makes for a very bright addition to the Oxford T25 bus series. In real life, the T3 VW transporter (or Type 25) was the successor to the T2 and came with a few more refinements. When it first came out, the T25 still incorporated an air cooled engine but later models progressed to water cooling. The vehicle was manufactured in Germany from 1979 to 1992 and was the last of the rear engined Volkswagens. The T3 was also produced under licence in South Africa from 1990 but purely for that market and featuring an Audi 5-cylinder engine. Production there lasted as late as 2002.

Scammell Pioneer Recovery Tractor - RAF

It's back to a military livery for this latest version of the Scammell Pioneer, which was used extensively through WWII, particularly as a recovery vehicle. After the conflict, the vehicle proved the workhorse for general heavy haulage duties as well.

Decorated in RAF blue livery and registered RAF 150078, additional detail on the model includes the RAF roundel

on the front and rear mudguards and RAF Recovery in white above the windscreen.

Morris J2 - RAF

The Morris Commercial J2 was a small, forward control van which the Morris Commercial subsidiary of BMC launched in 1956. It was produced until 1967 and marketed as both the Morris J2 and the Austin J2. The Oxford tooling provides for both these variants.

Our latest livery is a military one, as used by the RAF, decorated in the signature RAF blue-grey and registered 99 AR 59, which will appeal to post-war die-cast collectors of militaria. In service in

Germany, the words RAFG RHEIN are printed in white on the front. The Union Flag features on the left hand side wing in front of the door, while the RAF roundel appears on the front wing.




VW Minibus - Fjord Blue/Arcona White

VW Pick Up - Light Grey



Land Rover Series 1 80 inch Hard Top - RAC

The Land Rover, launched in 1948, was an instant success and an essential vehicle for users in an off road or rural environment. Its ability to function under all conditions made it a prime vehicle for such organisations as the RAC who used it extensively. The 80 inch description refers to the chassis, the other being the 88 inch, already in the Oxford range.

Our latest livery comes in the familiar traditional dark blue and white RAC Road Service colour scheme, registered KAD 265.

Special features to note include a spare wheel inside the vehicle, a spot light on the front bumper and the special Series I 80 inch radiator grille. Additional colour is added with a wealth of silver masking and a TOWING sign is also to be seen on the front bumper. The interior is a bronze green with black steering wheel.
