The second variant of the Oxford Armstrong Siddeley Hurricane, this time with the hood up. It is a replica of the elegant motor produced between 1946 and 1953. Only around 2600 were made of the real thing and not many changes were made to it during its production lifetime. Designed as a four seater, two door body - with suicide doors opening forwards - it was classed as a

drophead coupe and was based on the Lancaster of 1945. Featuring a 1991 or 2309 cc engine, it had a four speed manual gearbox and when launched cost £1151. You can have a superb

The second livery of the Armstrong Siddeley Lancaster brings us an Ivory version. A 1:43 scale of the elegant immediate post-war sports saloon, made by Armstrong Siddeley between 1945 and 1952. The four

and aluminum panel fitted over a wooden frame, bought in from the famous Mulliner company. With a sunshine roof fitted as standard, a rare wire wheel option and four-speed gearbox, it was the epitome of style after the dark days of WWII.

William Lyons launched the 2.5 litre saloon at the Mayfair Hotel in September 1935. The model was the first to carry the Jaguar name and cost £395. It was the

model was the first to carry the Ja name and cost £395. It was the first four-door car to come out of the SS Company and for the following two years, the Jaguars would have coach built bodies and wooden frames. By 1938, the car had been upgraded to include an all-steel frame - a Jaguar innovation

amongst small specialist car manufacturers. The SS Jaguar 2.5 litre saloon remained in production until 1949, during which time 6777 had been produced for the discerning motorists of the period.



The Jaguar Mark VII was a large four door sports sedan launched by Jaguar Cars of Coventry at the 1950 London

Motor Show. The chassis came from the Jaguar Mark V with which the Mark VII shared its 10 feet (3,048.0 mm) wheelbase. But for this latest offering Jaguar designed a modern and streamlined looking body, featuring fully integrated headlights and mudguards along with an increased rear

overhang which gave the car enhanced presence. As on the Mark V, the upper part of the rear wheels was

covered by the body work. In place of its predecessor's flat windscreen, the Mark VII design included a two piece front

screen, which would later become one when the MKVIII was launched. It had a speed of just over 100 mph (163 km/h) and could accelerate from 0-60 mph in 13.7 seconds -17.5 miles to the gallon and all for just under £1700.



The Commer Q25 Ambulance of the 1940-1960 era proved very versatile during its life. This Ambulance version, the 5th release off the new tool, will fill a gap in the collections of emergency vehicle enthusiasts. The Coventry branch of the Post Office Ambulance Corps - the first branch to buy its own vehicle, in 1963 purchased this particular example of the GPO ambulance fleet. It carries the authentic number plate MLB 986. Although completely separate from the St John Ambulance Brigade, the POAC were trained on similar lines and wore similar uniforms. The GPO ambulances were used to help staff in time of need as well as performing general public assistance

Our latest release of the Shelvoke and Drewery dustcart, in the Corporation of London livery. In their heyday they manufactured innovative waste collection vehicles, the preferred choice of municipal authorities throughout the UK. Founded in 1922 by Harry Shelvoke and

James Drewry, the Letchworth based company also manufactured fire engines, buses and forklift trucks.During WWII, like many

manufacturers, they switched their output to the production of components for the war effort. Sadly Shelvoke and Drewry were taken over in the 1980s by an American company - Dempster Brothers, which subsequently suffered financial problems. Part of the

company was integrated with Dennis, who had been Shelvoke and Drewrys main rival in times gone by. Dennis-Shelvoke continued for a while but ceased trading in 1992. The rear tips 90 degrees and also we supply an additional component which allows it to be posed tipping rubbish.




