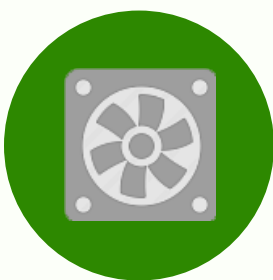

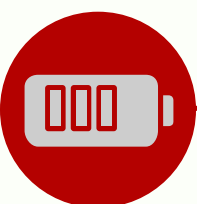

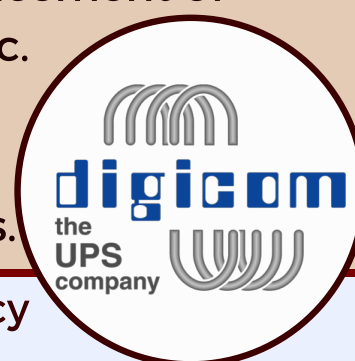
Applicable for installable 1 & 3 phase UPS in controlled environment.
