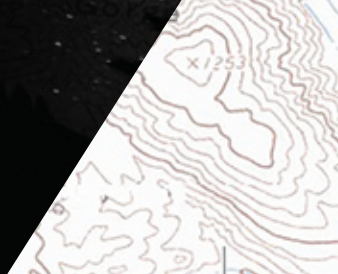

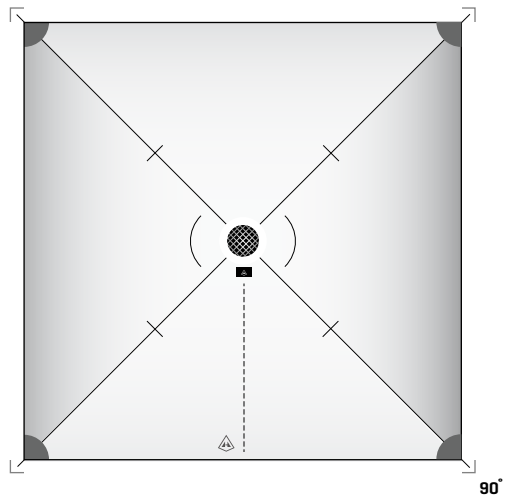

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS:

ULTAMID PYRAMID TENT

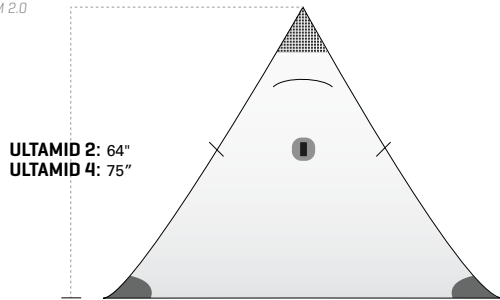
ZIP UP THE ULTAMID DOOR BEFORE LAYING IT OUT AND STAKING IT.

TEMPORARILY STAKE OUT THE ULTAMID WITH 90-DEGREE ANGLES AT EACH CORNER.

ADJUST EACH CORNER USING THE GUY LINES TO ACHIEVE THE REQUIRED ANGLES THROUGHOUT THIS PROCESS. THE GUYLINES SHOULD LINE UP WITH THE SEAMS OF THE ULTAMID.

CREATE THE CENTER POLE BY PLACING YOUR TREKKING POLE TIPS SIDE TO SIDE AND USING A SET OF ULTAMID POLE STRAPS TO BIND THEM TOGETHER.

DIAGRAM 2.0



SET THE CENTER POLE HEIGHT TO ~64" (163CM) FOR THE ULTAMID 2 AND ~75" (191CM) FOR THE ULTAMID 4.

NOTE - HOW HIGH THE CENTER POLE IS AND HOW MUCH GUYLINE IS EXTENDED WILL AFFECT HOW CLOSE THE BOTTOM OF THE ULTAMID IS TO THE GROUND.

UNZIP THE DOOR TO GET INSIDE THE ULTAMID AND INSERT THE CENTER POLE.

ADJUST THE HEIGHT TO GET THE ULTAMID TAUT ON ALL SIDES.

NOTE - TO ACHIEVE EVEN TENSION AMONGST ALL FOUR SIDE WALLS, YOU MAY HAVE TO LOOSEN TIGHT GUYLINES, AND TIGHTEN THE OPPOSING SIDES. EVENING OUT THE TENSION IS THE KEY TO FLAT, TAUT WALLS.

RE-ZIP THE ULTAMID DOOR AND MAKE ANY NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS TO THE STAKE OUT GUY LINES.

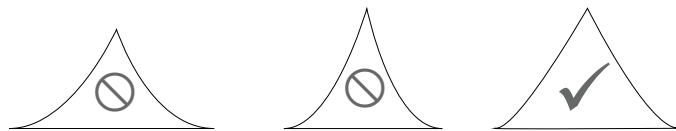

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS:

ULTAMID PYRAMID TENT INSERTS

NOTE – INSERTS ARE MOST EASILY INSTALLED AFTER THE ULTAMID HAS ALREADY BEEN PITCHED.

TEMPORARILY TAKE THE CENTER POLE OUT OF THE ULTAMID.

PLACE THE CENTER POLE INTO THE PEAK OF THE INSERT.

RE-RAISE THE ULTAMID WITH ONE END OF THE CENTER POLE IN THE INSERT'S PEAK AND THE OTHER CENTERED ONTO THE GROUND (OR REINFORCED PATCH FOR AN INSERT WITH A FLOOR).



FOR INSERT WITH DCF11 FLOOR: SPREAD OUT THE INSERT FLOOR AND CENTER THE POLE ON THE REINFORCED PATCH. NEXT, ATTACH THE CORNER SHOCK CORDS TO THE D-RINGS AT EACH CORNER OF THE ULTAMID. AND STAKE OUT THE CORNERS (RECOMMENDED, BUT OPTIONAL).

FOR INSERT WITH NO FLOOR: STRETCH THE INSERT CORNERS OUT TO ATTACH THEM TO THE D-RINGS ON EACH CORNER OF THE ULTAMID.

FOR HALF INSERT: STAKE OUT THE INSIDE CORNERS AND STRETCH THE WALL-SIDE CORNERS OUT TO ATTACH THEM TO THE D-RINGS ON EACH CORNER OF THE ULTAMID.

IMPORTANT: ADJUST THE INSERTS CORNER TENSION SHOCK CORDS AND STAKES UNTIL YOU ACHIEVE A TAUT PITCH.



OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

CLEANING: Take the time on a dry sunny day and wash your shelter out, spot-cleaning any areas that need it. A hose with a bucket of water and a mild soap (powdered detergent works well, do not use bleach) will work on any of our DCF fabrics. Air-dry your shelter by either pitching it and leaving it out with the door open or hang-dry it. Make sure your shelter is completely dry before storage. This will help protect the fabric and keep it safe from any damage.

STORAGE: Store your Hyperlite Mountain Gear products in a dry place with minimal fluctuation in temperature if possible.

ONGOING MAINTENANCE/STORAGE: Periodically check stake-out points and trekking pole contact areas for signs of stress or tears and repair any damage before continued use.

MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY: *If one of our products fails due to a manufacturer's defect within one year, the original purchaser may return it to us for repair, replacement or refund of the original purchase price at our discretion. This warranty protects the original owner against manufacturing defects in workmanship and materials. Damage due to wear and tear, accident, improper use, negligence, or the natural breakdown of materials over extended time and use is not covered.*

RETURN POLICY: *If you are not satisfied with a product purchased directly from Hyperlite Mountain Gear at the time you receive it, you may return it, unused, for a refund of your purchase price, within 15 days.*
