Position Summary/Job Scope

Operate Company's equipment especially those that require a CDL including manual transmission semi-truck. Perform equipment maintenance. Driver must be flexible to work extended hours during the primary harvest season (July- October).

Essential Job Functions/Responsibilities:

- Operate Company's equipment in accordance with company procedures, policies and safety standards
- Operate Company's Mack, Volvo and International truck tractors, Lowboy trailer, 46' dump trailers, and other equipment including but not limited to dump wagons and farm trucks in compliance with all Federal, State and Local regulations
- Operate water spray truck
- Must have experience with driving 10 speed manual transmission
- Have a tanker endorsement certification or willing to obtain a tanker endorsement upon hire
- Take good care of Company's assets
- Report any concerns with equipment condition and/or operation
- Responsibilities may include agricultural tasks and activities related to harvesting and collecting plant samples
- During the off-harvest season, the position will involve vehicle maintenance and assisting in other operations and factory-related tasks, including but not limited to assisting with seed harvest and greenhouse operations, facilities buildout, equipment maintenance and other tasks as required
- Perform daily and periodic maintenance on agricultural, support and auxiliary equipment
