
Rule for Safe Riding

- This vehicle has adjustable play seat belts. Please instruct children how to tie the safety belt before using, guarantee the security.







Secure Steering Column & Front Axle | 10




- · Gently turn the vehicle body upside down.
- 1. Insert the bend end of the steering column into the hole on the front axle.
- 2. Fit a Ø10 plastic washer (18) on the t3. Insert a split pin (19) into the hole on the bent end of the steering column, bend the ends of split pin back using a long nose pliers (not included).
- 4. Remove the M5x16 screw, plastic washer, and nut from the front wheel axle. (Fig. E6)
- 5. Adjust the Front wheel axle so that the axle is in the correct position as shown (Fig. 1).
- **6.**Then reinsert the **M5x16** screw, plastic washer and washer as shown, make sure the plastic washer sits on the front axle plate, also ensure the Front Axle Plate sits over the Steering Linkage as shown with the stopper, to prevent fingers becoming trapped while steering, attach the **locknut** and tighten securely. **(Fig. E6)**




- 1. Slide a Ø12 Washer (4) onto the front axle.
- 2. Slide a Front wheel (2) onto the front axle.
- 3. Slide a Ø12 Washer (4) onto the front axle.
- 4. Tighten a lock nut (5) to the end of the front axle with a spanner (7).
- DO NOT over tighten.

5. Insert the tabs on the **wheel cover (6)** into the slots on the **Front wheel**. Repeat for the other front **Front wheel**.

Attach the Rear Wheels





- Cut off the rubber band over the rear gear boxes.
- 1. Slide a rear wheel (2) onto the rear axle. Ensure the rear wheel (2) matches up with the gear box.
- 2. Slide another Ø12 washer (4) onto the rear axle.
- 3. Tighten a lock nut (5) to the end of the rear axle with a spanner (7).
- Repeat the above procedure to assemble the other rear wheel to the rear axle. HINT: An extra spanner has been provided to hold the Lock Nut on the other side of the rear axle while tightening the Lock Nut on the other side.
- 4. Insert the tabs on the wheel cover (6) into the grooves on the rear wheel.
- Repeat for the other rear wheel.




Turn the vehicle body over.

- 1. Fit the Handle Bar (8) to the end of the steering column.
- 2. Line up the holes on the **Handle Bar** with the holes on the **steering column**, insert the **M5x25 machine screw (10)**. Fasten a Ø5 nut (9) on the opposite end of the **M5x25 machine screw**. Using **long nose pliers** to hold the Ø5 nut while tightening the **M5x25 machine screw** with a **screwdriver**.
- 4. Fit luggage carrier (11) to the vehicle body (1).
- 5. Tighten with three Ø5x16 screws (14) to secure.






- 1. Fit the front roll bar (13) to the vehicle body (1).
- 2. Insert the four Ø4x12 screws (12) and tighten with a screwdriver.
- 3. Fit the back rest (16) into the holes on the vehicle body.
- 4. Insert two Ø4x12 screws and tighten with a screwdriver.









- 1. Turn the luggage carrier (11) upside down. Fit the rear roll bar (15) to the luggage carrier as shown above.
- 2. Insert the two Ø4x12 (12) screws and tighten with a screwdriver.
- 3. Fit the rear luggage carrier assembly over the rear of vehicle body. (Fig. 2)
- 4. Insert three Ø5x16 screws (14) through the luggage carrier and into the vehicle body, tighten with a screwdriver.


5. Insert two Ø4x12 screws through the rear roll bar and into the vehicle body, and




Connect the Power Supply | 15



- 1. Plug the battery connector into the red vehicle connector as shown. (Fig. 3)
- 2. Fit the tabs on the seat (13) into the grooves on the vehicle body (1).
- 3. Tighten a Ø4X12 screw (12) to secure the seat to the vehicle body.



Use your Ride On 16



1. Start Button: Starts the Vehicle

2. Forward / Reverse switch.

Changes the direction that vehicle moves from forward to reverse

HINT: The vehicle is designed to operate in low speed only in reverse.

3. High-low speed switch: Changes the vehicle moves in high speed and low speed in forward.

4. Foot Pedal:

To move the vehicle, press the pedal down.


To brake or slow down, release pressure from the pedal.

Charging | 17

- The POWER SWITCH must be turned in "OFF" position when charging.
- Before the first use, you should charge the battery for 4-6 hours. Do not recharge the battery for more than 10 hours to avoid overheating the charger
- When the vehicle begins to run slowly, recharge the battery.



- 1. Plug the charger port into the input socket. (The socket is at the back of the vehicle)
- 2. Plug the charger plug into a wall outlet. The battery will begin charging

- · Do not allow the battery to drain completely. Recharge the battery after each use or once a month if not used regularly.
- · Do not charge the battery upside down.
- · Always secure the battery with the bracket. Battery can fall out and injure a child if vehicle tips over.
- · The POWER SWITCH must be turned in OFF position when charging.
- · Before the first use, you should charge the battery for 4-6 hours. Do not recharge the battery for more than 10 hours to avoid overheating the charger.
- · When the vehicle begins to run slowly, recharge the battery.
- · After each use or once a month minimum recharge time as 8 to 12 hours, less than 20 hours at most.

Battery Replacement & Fuse | 19

The battery features a thermal fuse with a rest fuse that will automatically trip and cut all power to the vehicle if the motor, electric system or battery is overloaded. The fuse will reset and power will be restored after the unit is turned OFF for 20 seconds and then turned ON again. If the thermal fuse trips repeatedly during normal use, the vehicle may need repair. **Contact your distributor please.**

To avoid losing power, follow these guidelines:

- · Do not overload the vehicle.
- Do not tow anything behind the vehicle.
- · Do not drive up steep slopes.
- Do not drive into fixed objects, which may cause the wheels to spin, causing the motor to overheat.
- Do not drive in very hot weather, components may overheat.
- Do not allow water or other liquids to come in contact with the battery or other electric components.
- Do not tamper with the electric system. Doing so may create a short, causing the fuse to trip.

Battery Disposal





Recycle the dead battery responsibly. The battery contains lead acid (electrolyte) and must be disposed of properly and legally. It is illegal in most areas to incinerate lead acid batteries or dispose of them in landfills. Take it to a federal or state-approved lead acid battery recycler, such as local automotive battery retailer. Do not throw the battery away with your regular household waste!

Maintaining 21

- It is parents' responsibility to check main parts of the toy before using. Regular examination of transformer or battery charger for any damage to their cord, plug, enclosure and other parts, and that, in the event of such damage, toy must not be used with the transformer or battery charger until such damage has been repaired.
- Make sure the plastic parts of the vehicle are not cracked or broken.
- Park the vehicle indoors or cover it with a tarp to protect it from wet weather.
- Keep the vehicle away from sources of heat, such as stoves and heaters. Plastic may melt.
- Recharge the battery after each use. Only an adult can handle the battery. Recharge the battery at least once a month when the vehicle is not being used.
- Do not wash the vehicle with a hose. Do not wash the vehicle with soap and water. Do not drive the vehicle in rainy or snowy weather. Water will damage the motor, electric system and battery.
- Clean the vehicle with a soft, dry cloth. To restore shine to plastic parts, use a non-wax furniture polish. Do not use car wax. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Do not drive the vehicle in loose dirt, sand or fine gravel which could damage the moving parts, motors or the electric system.
- When not using, all the electrical source should be turned off. Turn off the power switch and disconnect the battery connection.
