Position Summary/Job Scope

Dry indigo biomass materials through a proprietary drying system in a safe and efficient manner in accordance with company's manufacturing standards, procedures and policies. The individual must be flexible to work extended hours during the primary harvest season. This position is a seasonal position that may lead to a permanent full-time position.

Essential Job Functions/Responsibilities:

- Manufacturing process knowledge is mainly obtained by "on-the-job training" by experienced Plant Operators and/or Production Supervisor.
- Follow established manufacturing and operating procedure.
- Operate a continuous drying production line on assigned shift.
- Ability to multi-task.
- Responsible for in-process quality control sampling and testing to ensure compliance with established quality procedures and specifications.
- Document/record all production runs operating parameters as required.
- Report to Production Supervisor any issues or concerns related to manufacturing, equipment and/or maintenance in a timely manner.
- Monitor equipment and assigned processes for performance and consistency.
- Perform standard material handling functions including loading and packaging of crop biomass.
- Provide necessary input to promote safety, teamwork and process improvements.
- Participate in production meetings.
- During the off-season, assist with factory and process expansion projects/tasks, perform equipment seasonal maintenance and other tasks as directed by Supervisor and/or Management.

- Reading comprehension, writing and organizational skills
- Ability to independently function and follow directions
- Aptitude for learning various manufacturing skills
- Shift schedule flexibility
