#### **FABRICS & NOTIONS**

1 3/4 yds. Lightweight Muslin 10" of 1/4" wide Braided Elastic 10" of 1/8" wide Braided Elastic 6 Small Snaps DMC Floss:

1 skein #604 Pink

1 skein #972 Goldenrod

1 skein #550 Purple

1 skein #996 Med. Blue

1 skein #666 Red

1 skein #915 Fuchsia

2 1/2 skeins #699 Green

Red Thread - decorative trim on dress

# READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE CUTTING OUT FABRIC AND NOTIONS.

NOTE: 1. WRST, indicates With Right Sides Together.

- 2. All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise indicated.
- 3. Finish all seams with a serge or zigzag edge.
- 4. The design on this dress can be hand embroidered, purchased appliqués, painted with fabric paing, or cut and sew on hand-made fabric appliqués. Transfers are provided for tracing design onto fabric. OR, trace design onto

another piece of paper; then make photocopies. These photocopies can be used as iron-on transfers. Embroider with a satin stitch; using 3 strands of embroidery thread for all embroidery.

## DRESS CONSTRUCTION:

- On skirt front; bring solid lines to meet at center seam. Baste. Bring solid lines together on side tucks, pressing tucks toward the side segam. Baste across upper edge. SEE DIAGRAM A.
- 2. For skirt back; repeat procedure pressing tucks toward the back seam. Finish each back center seam. Baste across upper edte.
  - 3. WRST, sew gore to front side seam. Sew back side seam to gore. Repeat for other side. SEE DIAGRAM B.
  - 4. WRST, sew front voke to back voke at shoulders. WRST, sew sleeve under seams to dot.
- WRST, sew youke facings together at shoulders. Finish seams and outer edges of facings. WRST, sew facings to yoke neckline. Trim. Clip corners being careful not to clip stitches.
- 6. Pin skirt front to yoke front. Pivot at dots, keeping under-sleeve as flat as possible. Pin skirt back to yoke back. Stitch. Finish seam. Press yoke back facing, back yoke and center back self-facing to the inside at fold lines. **SEE DIAGRAM C.** 
  - 7. Press yoke facing to the inside over yoke. hand tack facing in place. hand sew snaps to back yoke.
- 8. Narrow hem sleeve edges and skirt hem. Using a decorative or zig-zag machine stitch; sew with red thread around hem edge, neckline, sleeve edges and yoke lower edge. Decorate dress with method of choice.

#### SLIP CONSTRUCTION:

- WRST, sew front to back at shoulders. Finish neck and armhole edges. Turn to inside 1/4" and topstitch 1/8" from edge.
- 10. WRST, sew side seams. Finish lower slipe edge. Turn to inside 1/4". Topstitch 1/8" from finished edge. Press back center edges to inside 1/2". Hand sew snaps at markings. SEE PATTERN FOR PLACEMENT.

# PANTIES CONSTRUCTION: (Leg Elastic 5") (Waist Elastic 10")

- 11. WRST, sew center front and center back seams.
- 12. Finish lower leg edges. Turn edge to the inside 3/8". Stitch 1/4" from fabric edge to form a casing.
- 13. Insert the 1/8" wide elastic into each leg casing. Sew elastic ends in seam allowance.
- 14. WRST, sew the crotch/inseam, making sure to catch in the elastic ends.
- 15. Turn upper edge to the inside 1/4". Turn again to form the wasit casing. Stitch leaving an opening for inserting the 1/4" elastic. Insert the elastic, overlapping the ends. Machine stitch the opening closed.

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
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
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
