yds. 2" Flat Eyelet Lace - dress, panties, collar

3/4 yd. White Batiste - panties, collar, skirt lining
1/3 yd. 1/4" Braided Elastic - panties
2/3 yd. 1/8" Braided Elastic - sleeves, panties
3 Small Snaps - dress
2 Small Buttons - collar
1 yd. 2" wide Satin Ribbon - sash 1 1/4 yds. 5/8" Flat Eyelet Lace - skirt lining

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE CUTTING FABRIC AND NOTIONS NOTE: 1 All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise indicated

Finish all seams with a serge or zigzag edge.

WRST, indicates With Right Sides Together

DRESS CONSTRUCTION:

- WRST, sew the shoulder seams. Repeat same procedure for the bodice lining
- WRST sew bodice backs and neck edges. Trim seam to 1/8", turn and press
- stitch 1/4" from finished edge forming a casing. Insert 4" of 1/8" elastic. Anchor ends. V/RST, serge 16" of the 2" flat lace to the lower edge of sleeve. Press seam up to the casing line.
- center of sleeve to the shoulder seams Sew two rows of gathering stitches across the sleeve cap. WRST, sew the sleeves to the bodice, matching
- WRST, sew side and underarm seams together, making sure to catch elastic in the seam
- WRST, sew center back seam leaving 3" open on upper edge. Repeat same procedure for the lining Treat the skirt and lining as one piece. Sew two rows of gathering threads across the top of the skirt.
- WRST, sew the bodic to the skirt.
- the eyelet lace hanging free. Sew the hem on the skirt. Turn up hem on dress. WRST, sew the 2" flat eyelet lace to the hem edge of skirt. Fold up skirt hem, leaving
- Serge the 5/8" flat eyelet lace to the hem edge of skirt lining
- Sew three snaps to the back edge of bodice

COLLAR CONSTRUCTION:

- keeping a pin at either end to anchor the gathering threads Gather 60" of the 2" flat lace to fit the collar. I pinned the lace around the entire collar, then remove the lace
- WRST, sew the entredeux to the gathered lace. First stitching in the ditch of the entredeux, then with a
- in the down position, clip and pivot at each corner point 14 WRST, sew the entredeux to the collar, clipping the entredeux at the corners. I stop sewing with the needle
- With a small zigzag, stitch close to the previous stitching You may use Fray Check® on the seam. Trim
- opposite back. Remember that the neck edge is sewn in a 1/8" seam 17. Trim seam to 1/8", clip curves. Press. 16. WRST, sew the collar to the collar lining, starting at the back, around the neck edge and finishing up on the
- Turn under the collar lining 1/4" and whip stitch to the collar
- Sew two small buttons on the left back. Tused thread loops for my closure, you can also use snaps behind

PANTIES CONSTRUCTION: (Waist Elastic 11") (Leg Elastic 6")

- WRST, sew the center front and the center back seams
- ends and stitch. Machine stitch the opening closed. Turn down the waist casing and sew, leaving an opening for inserting elastic. Insert the 1/4" elastic.
- Machine stitch close to the edge forming a casing. Insert the leg efastic anchoring the ends 15. WRST, serge 13" of the 2" lace to each of the lower edges of the legs. Press seam up to the casing line
- WRST, sew the crotch/inseam making sure to catch in the elastic ends
