Dr. Herbst is an M.D. board certified radiologist with a Ph.D. in physical chemistry who completed a fellowship in MRI and is now practicing in St. Petersburg, Florida. He is a nationally known expert in MRI, but he reads all kinds of medical images, including x-rays, CT scans, ultrasounds, and nuclear medicine scans, specializing in musculoskeletal radiology and neuroradiology.

Dr. Herbst also lectures to physicians, attorneys, and insurance case managers around the country about radiology subjects such as MRI, radiology errors, disc herniations, and brain injury.

Attorneys from the United States and Canada send medical images to Dr. Herbst for his unbiased review.
