
How does the RAC 107 work?

The RAC 107 records video onto a micro SD card which is fitted into a slot on the camera.

The amount of video stored depends on the size of SD card being used, the RAC 107 can support SD cards with a capacity of up to 32GB. As a guide, when recording in HD, 9 minutes of video uses about 1GB of space on the SD card.

The RAC 107 records in segments, the length of which is pre-set to 3 minutes, but can be adjusted using the simple menu functions on the camera.

When the SD card is full, the RAC 107 operates on a loop recording system, overwriting the oldest recording and continues to record without the need to erase or download any data.

Key Features

Video Recording – Records your drive in HD video day/night.

Discreet Recording - The camera display screen turns off after a short time so that the driver's view is not interrupted – in the background the camera is recording everything on the road ahead.

Photo Mode – Captures still images as well as video, which could be very useful in an accident or incident in the road.

Microphone and Speaker – Sounds and conversations can be recorded, if required. If not, a simple one touch button will mute the microphone.

Emergency Button – When pressed, the current sector of your recording becomes protected, and will not be lost when the camera continues recording.

360° Revolving Cradle - Position your camera in different directions with the rotating mount enclosed in the box.

The RAC 107 can be powered using the supplied power cable connected to a vehicle's 12 volt power socket or hard-wired.



RAC 107 Dash Cam Quick Start Guide:

The RAC 107 Dash Cam is designed to be fitted onto the vehicle windscreen, using the supplied suction pad.



1	USB Port for power adaptor	8	OK button
2	Lens	9	Mode button
3	LCD	10	Lock button
4	SD Card slot	11	Power button
5	Up button	12	Microphone
6	Menu button	13	Reset

- 1 The RAC 107 should be attached to the vehicle in car power supply at all times. The internal battery is for emergency use only, for example, to take still pictures in the event of an incident.
- 2 The RAC 107, when connected to the in vehicle power supply, will turn on and off with the engine. Once it has been set up, it can be left in place without need for adjustment or further setting. The RAC 107 records using loop technology, so when the SD card is full, the RAC 107 will automatically overwrite the oldest files and continue recording indefinitely.
- 3 It is recommended that you check the RAC 107 at least once a month to make sure it is operating and recording properly. The RAC 107 has a screen saver setting, so that after a short time the screen turns off. This setting can be adjusted by accessing the relevant menu setting.
- 4 If you wish to view the footage recorded by the RAC 107 you can do this in three ways:
 - a) remove the SD card from the RAC 107 and using a SD card reader (not supplied), insert into a computer. Files can then be viewed in the same way as a digital camera.
 - b) connect the camera to a computer using a sync cable (not supplied). Files can then be viewed in the same way as a digital camera.
 - c) push the REC/OK button to stop recording and then push the MODE button twice. Files can then be viewed on the dash cam, using the up and down buttons to scroll between videos.

RAC 107 Dash Cam Set up Guide:

Everything required to set up and use the RAC 107 is included in the box.

- 1 Connect the suction pad to the RAC 107
- 2 Insert the USB end of the car charger into the RAC 107
- 3 Fit the RAC 107 with suction pad onto the windscreen.
- 4 Any excess cable can normally be tucked into the ceiling of the vehicle. We have a video to advise on how best to fit the RAC 107 which is available at www.proofcam.com and visit "Camera Resources". You can also search "How to fit an RAC 107" on YouTube.
- 5 Insert the charger end of the car charger into the in vehicle power socket.

- 6 A protective film on the lens will affect the video or photographic effect, remove the protective film before using the dash cam.
- 7 Start the engine and the RAC 107 will turn on and start recording immediately.
Note - if your vehicle in car power remains on after the car engine has been turned off, you may need to remove the power lead, or turn the RAC 107 off using the power button. This is because if the in car power remains on, the RAC 107 will not know that the engine has been turned off.
- 8 If you wish to set the time, or adjust any menu settings, push the OK button, which will stop the RAC 107 recording, and then push the MENU button to enter the Menu. There is only one menu level, scroll up and down using the two buttons in the left side, and then select the menu items you wish to change by pushing the OK button.
