Door finish:

All our Heritage & Traditional products are hand prepared with a premium high quality primer, these paint materials have been scientifically designed for our use in Germany from the world leading paint supplier "Remmers" and although we realise that some customers may feel the finish is more than enough the addition of a topcoat is required before hanging and then touching up thereafter, please remember the top and bottom edges are always left unfinished.

One point to note is that all primed or painted doors but especially black primed doors will show movement between door rails and panels, the panel will possibly show "shrinkage" in the finish at the edges which will ultimately lead to customers unease, this is not a manufacturing issue, these doors need to be finished on site.

Paint details from the factory, please use the top coat paint provided for touching up the edges of the door in the event the edges are planed back to bare timber during installation. Gloss level on the grey and white is 15-20% and the black is 10-15%

All doors require a top coat. A 750ml can of top coat is included.
