

## Door finish:

The description is correct when it states these doors are **PRIMED** in the colour shown, the finish is a prime plus and most customers will probably not feel the need to use a topcoat before hanging, however, especially with the black primed door, any movement at all in the panel will cause "cracking" in the finish which will ultimately lead to many customer service issues where customers feel it is a manufacturing issue but it is not as these doors need to be finished on site.

Below are some details to aid our customers in finishing the doors on site:

## **RAL NUMBERS:**

Black - RAL 9005 Grey - RAL 7044 White - RAL 9003

## Comments regarding paint from the factory:

The paint used is PU so solvent based. Therefore best to use oil based paint for touch up on the face of the door.

If the edges are planed back to bare timber you could get away with water based paint.

Gloss level on the grey and white is 15-20% and the black is 10-15%.
