### **Fabric Requirements**

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard Fleur-C7970 Cream

1 yard Fleur-C7972 Cream

1 yard Fleur-C7977 Green (includes ½ yard for binding)

<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yard Fleur-C7979 Cream

5/8 yard Fleur-C7973 Cream

31/4 yards backing of your choice

 $58" \times 70"$  batting

## **Cutting**

#### From Fleur-C7970 Cream:

• Cut two  $11^{1}/2^{11} \times \text{width of fabric (WOF) strips.}$ Sub-cut six  $11^{1}/2^{11} \times \text{squares.}$ 

#### From Fleur-C7972 Cream:

• Cut six 5" × WOF for outer border.

#### From Fleur-C7977 Green:

- Cut four  $2^{1/2}$ " × WOF strips.
- Cut five  $1^{1/2}$ " × WOF strips.
- Cut six  $2^{1/2}$ " × WOF strips for binding.

#### From Fleur-C7979 Cream:

- Cut eleven  $1^1/2^n \times \text{WOF}$  strips. Sub-cut three  $1^1/2^n \times 35^1/2^n$  strips, two  $1^1/2^n \times 25^1/2^n$  strips and four  $1^1/2^n \times 11^1/2^n$  strips. Set remaining strips aside for narrow border.
- Cut one  $4"\times WOF$  strip. Sub-cut four 4" squares.

#### From Fleur-C7973 Cream:

• Cut five 4" × WOF strips.

## **Quilt Top Assembly**

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right side together.

- 1. Lay out the six 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7970 Cream squares in two columns of three blocks each.
- 2. Sew one  $1^{1}/2^{11} \times 11^{1}/2^{11}$  C7979 Cream strip between the three blocks to make a column. Repeat to complete the second column.
- 3. Sew one  $1^{1}/2^{11} \times 35^{1}/2^{11}$  C7979 Cream strip between the two columns, aligning adjacent block seams. Sew one  $1^{1}/2^{11} \times 35^{1}/2^{11}$  C7979 Cream strip to each side of the center blocks.
- 4. Sew one  $1^{1/2}$ " ×  $25^{1/2}$ " C7979 Cream strip to the top and other to the bottom of the center blocks.
- 5. Sew together the  $2^{1/2}$ " × WOF C7977 Green strips end to end. Measure the quilt center length and cut two strips to that measurement. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
- 6. Measure the quilt center width and cut two 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7977 Green strips that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.
- 7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 using the remaining 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7979 Cream strips to make and apply the next border.
- 8. Sew together the 4" × WOF C7973 Cream strips end to end. Measure the quilt center width and cut two strips that length. Sew one 4" C7979 Cream square to each end of each cut C7973 Cream strip and set aside.
- 9. Measure the quilt center length and cut two C7973 Cream strips that measurement. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
- 10. Sew one of the C7973 Cream strips with cornerstones from step 8 to the top and other to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 11. Repeat steps 5 and 6 using remaining 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" C7977 Green strip to make and apply the next border.
- 12. Repeat steps 5 and 6 using six  $5" \times WOF$  C7972 Cream strips to make and apply the outer border.

# **Finishing**

- 13. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 14. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 15. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
