Girls School Uniform

- School Skirt or Grey Trousers
- Plain Blue Blouse **OR** Plain White Blouse
- Crested Navy Jumper *
- Navy Knee High Socks/Tights
- Formal Black Leather **Shoes**
- Plain Black Coat OR Plain Navy Coat

- Crested Tracksuit Bottoms *
- Crested Black PE T-Shirt * (x2)
- Crested ¹/₄ Zip Midlayer * OR Crested Fleece *
- Runners
- Crested Shorts * (Rugby Only)
- St. Conleths' Sports Socks (Rugby Only)

Girls Sportswear

- Crested Tracksuit Bottoms *
- Crested Black PE T-Shirt * (x2)
- Crested ¹/₄ Zip Midlayer * OR Crested Fleece *
- Runners
- School Skort (Hockey Only)
- St. Conleth's Sports Socks (Hockey Only)

PLEASE NOTE:

- Full school uniform must be worn to and from school.
- Students are **not permitted** to change into or out of school uniform on arriving or leaving school
- Only **School Crested Sportswear** is permitted for P.E. and Sport.
- All items of uniform should be clearly labelled with student's name.
- Hoodies and Multi Coloured outer garments <u>are strictly forbidden</u>.
- Runners are only permitted to be worn with the school tracksuit.
- Students are expected to have recourse to spare items of uniform in the event of clothing or footwear being soiled or lost.
- Hair must adhere to acceptable standards, natural colour only.

Contravention of these school rules will result in sanctions being applied.
