It would be sensible to lay a sheet or blanket on the floor where you intend to work to avoid scratching this product and to protect your floor


This product is heavy. Take extreme care when lifting to avoid personal injury or damage to the product.

Assemble the product as close to its intended final position in the room as possible.



HANDY HINT: If you keep the hardware in a bowl during assembly you will be less likely to lose them.




Your Remote Control and Power Lead can be found inside the Footboard of the bed. Please remove and connect the power lead as shown in the diagram.



TV LIFT GUIDE

IF FOR ANY REASON THE TV LIFT DOES NOT WORK,PLEASE CHECK THE FOLLOWING.

Check Power

Open the lid;one can easily see the controller on left hand side of the TV Lift.
When power is feeding through to the TV Lift-the light(1) is glowing.

If it is NOT glowing-power is not reaching the system.Check mains power is switched on and the plug is pushed firmly into the power socket on bottom of footboard.

Check Battery in the Switch

Battery Replacement

Battery Specification : A23 12V

Tools Required : Crosshead Screwdriver


Remove the switch from the side rail of the bed then follow the simple steps below:

Step 1 : Take off the front buttons of the switch by pushing the 2 locking clips inwards together.

Step 2 : Change the battery,making sure that the new battery is correctly located between the terminals.

The switch can then be re-assembled.

Test the switch and if the lift mechanism activates, re-mount in position on the side rail of the bed.



General Care

Wipe clean with a slightly damp soft cloth.

Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

When moving your furniture, carefully lift into place.

Never drag or push the pieces across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints and could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.

Recommendations

Periodical re-tightening of fixings.
