Situated between 1,700 and 2,000 meters above sea level and flanked by Nyungwe Forest National Park, this station thrives amidst a bustling atmosphere, employing up to 120 staff during the intensive four-month harvest season. Benefiting from prime growing conditions along the shores of Kivu Lake, Karambi epitomizes Rwanda's commitment to excellence in coffee production, with its strategic location and meticulous quality control ensuring exceptional coffee output.
