When springtime comes in Texas, we're already thinking about summer. This coffee from farmers in Northern Peru's Huabal district maintains the chocolate notes of a wintery coffee while hinting at the refreshing flavors of summertime.

**Producer:** 11 Smallholder Farmers  
**Altitude:** 1700-2000 m  
**Process:** Washed  
**Cultivar:** Caturra, Typica, Icatu  
**Use:** Filter

All eleven farmers who contributed to this lot are based in El Paraíso, a village in the Huabal district of Jaén, Cajamarca. Aptly named 'paradise', the village center is atop a small mountain at 2000 meters, with beautiful vistas in every direction. Like many remote producers, farmers in this area have received conflicting advice over the years. A farmer needs to make many choices that are highly specific to her site, such as variety choice, pruning style, and fertilization technique. Our partners in this area are working with a field team to address the needs of each individual farm and clear up misconceptions so that these farmers can continue to produce beautiful coffees.
