BSV is run by the Paz family, who support and represent a network of farmers that have become synonymous with specialty coffee in Honduras. Miguel Guzman's story is all about the rebound. Guzman began producing specialty coffee with the support of BSV in 2011, but the following year his farm was destroyed by a devastating fungus known as roya. Guzman is a positive guy with a good sense of humor--and the tenacity to bounce back. Miguel started over from scratch and placed 11th in Honduras' 2013 Cup of Excellence competition. Since then, he's continued to produce great quality on his family farm, called "Los Tres Juanes."
