Soft tannins with a nice - rich mid pallet offering the perfect sensory wine experience. This 2014 Thomas Knoll Estate is designed to pair well with food but stands alone proudly.

2014 VINTAGE NOTES

2014 was a great year for growing fruit in Napa. The summer of 2014 was cooler than 2013 and largely uninterrupted by the heat spikes. Thanks to the cool conditions, the wines have retained a fresh fruit and bright acidity characteristic.
