

Crochet directions for blanket throw, magic knot:

Here are the directions that Donna gave me. I honestly can't remember how many I chained to start something like 200? I have about 200 v stitches at the top of the blanket.

Anyway, chain desired amount. turn. go into 3rd chain from hook, 1dc. skip 2 chains, do 3dc in next chain. repeat following to almost the end: \*Skip 2 chains, do 3dc\* at end of chain, do 2dc. turn. chain 3.

Established row: do one dc in first "hole"?? (not sure what you call it). after that, do 3 dc in each hole until you reach almost the end. Do 2 dc in ending hole (I assume that is your turning chain). Repeat established row pattern.

To make the blanket look like "Pointillism" I change colors every row using the [magic knot](#) technique. I am alternating a bright color and a neutral color every other row.

If you are an avid crocheter, these directions should make sense to you! I dabble in crochet from time to time, but am no means an expert.
