Washing and Conditioning

- Brush your hair gently with a natural boar bristle brush, in the same direction as the extensions were installed to release the hair into a free flow.
- Wet your hair completely by gently lifting your tabs to allow the water to run all the way down to the scalp for full saturation.
- Gather a small amount of shampoo into your palm and rub it around your hands like lotion. Massage the cleanser into your scalp area above the top row of tape-in hair extensions.
- Gather the cleanser into the palm of your hand and rub it around your hands like lotion. Gently work the pads of your fingers in between the rows of tape-in hair extensions, press your scalp and scrub in a back and forth motion horizontal within the rows. Avoid scrubbing up and down as not to over direct the tabs. Do not be afraid to press your scalp to cleanse. This action will cause suds to occur and allow the cleanser to do its job removing dirt and debris from your scalp.
- Gather cleaners into your hands and rib around your hands like lotion. Press into the mid shafts and ends of your tape-in hair extensions using a squeezing motion. Do not vigorously rub your extensions together as this can cause matting and tangling.
- Rinse the cleanser out of your hair completely while gently lifting your extensions to allow the water to wash away the dislodged dirt and debris.
- If you use conditioner, apply a small amount of conditioner to the top of your hair above the extension line, away from the scalp, avoiding the tape-in hair extension tab completely.
- DO NOT apply conditioner to your scalp where the tape-in hair extensions are installed.
- Generously apply conditioner to your mid-lengths and ends. Make sure to avoid conditioners containing keratins.
- Thoroughly and completely rinse the conditioner from your making sure there is no residue left.
- DO NOT wrap your hair in a towel above your head after cleaning, instead press the moisture out of your hair from side to side
- Leave-in conditioners and styling products can be used taking care to avoid the tape-in hair extension tab area.
