

# HOW TO MEASURE YOUR DOCK LEVELER SPRING



# **Find the Length**

The length of your spring is measured from inside of hook - to - inside of hook. Some estimation may be required if your spring is broken.

### **Outside Diameter**

Measure the outside diameter to the nearest 1/8". For large (main lifting) springs, the "OD" can measure up to 4".



# **Coil Count**

Simply count the coils from one end to the other. Your count might be in-between if you end with a half wrap. Typical coil counts for main leveler springs is 20-30 coils.



#### **Coil Diameter**

If you don't have a digital caliper handy, some basic math will do the trick. Count 20 coils and record the length of the 20 coils. Then divide your length by 20. For example - if 20 coils measures 8-3/4" then take 8.75/20 = 0.4375

#### **Double Check & Order**

It's always a good idea to reference your owner's manual to confirm the part number. Remember to replace springs in pairs to ensure even pull & always follow safety precautions outlined by the equipment manufacturer.
