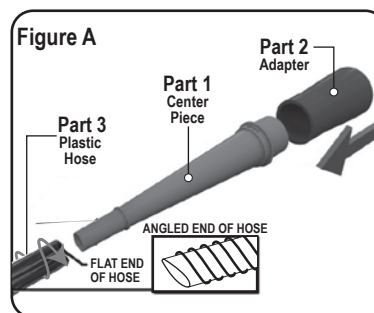

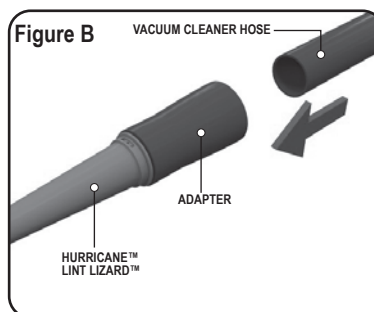
Assembling the Hurricane® Lint Lizard®:

- Insert the Hurricane® Lint Lizard® Center Piece (part 1) into the Hurricane® Lint Lizard® adapter (part 2) as shown in figure A.
- Twist the flat end of the plastic hose (part 3) onto the front of Center Piece (part 1) of the Hurricane® Lint Lizard® as shown in figure A.



Attaching the Hurricane® Lint Lizard®:

- Insert your vacuum hose into the Hurricane® Lint Lizard® adapter (figure B).



Using the Hurricane® Lint Lizard®:

- Locate your dryer's lint trap. Dryers may vary, but typical locations include the top of the dryer or in the front opening of the dryer door.
- Once the trap is located, follow the directions on your dryer to remove the lint trap.
- Remove the lint collected on the trap screen by hand.
- Turn on your vacuum† with the Hurricane® Lint Lizard® attached and use the hose to remove any lint that remains on the trap screen.

* Fits Most Clothes Dryers

† Will not fit some stick vacuums that only allow their brand's accessories

CONTINUE ON BACK

Using the Hurricane® Lint Lizard®:

- The Hurricane® Lint Lizard® features adjustable suction to suit your cleaning needs. To reduce the suction pressure, locate the suction control ring on the hurricane® Lint Lizard® and adjust by rotating the ring as shown in figure C. The ring has 3 positions, each one further reduces suction.
- With the dryer trap screen still removed, insert the hose of the Hurricane® Lint Lizard® directly into the lint trap. Keep the vacuum hose and Lint Lizard® vertical to help avoid any clogs as shown in figure D.
- Once no more lint can be seen being vacuumed through the hose, your dryer lint trap is now clean! Remove the hose and be sure to turn off your vacuum.

For An Even Deeper Clean:

- Locate your dryer's exterior vent. Homes will vary, But typical locations are not far from the dryer and are located outside of an exterior wall of the house.
- Once the vent is located, simply insert the hose of the Lint Lizard® into the vent, turn on the vacuum and remove the lint as in figure E.
- Once no more lint can be seen being vacuumed through the hose, your dryer lint trap is now clean! Remove the hose and be sure to turn off your vacuum.

Storing the Lint Lizard®:

- Do not remove the hose once it is attached.
- Store your Lint Lizard® in a cool, dry place.

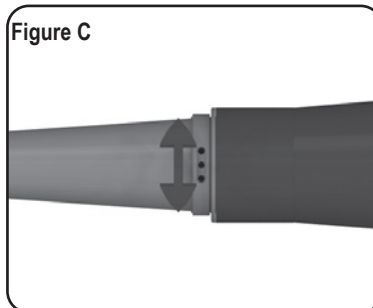

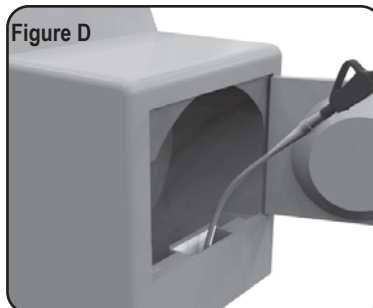
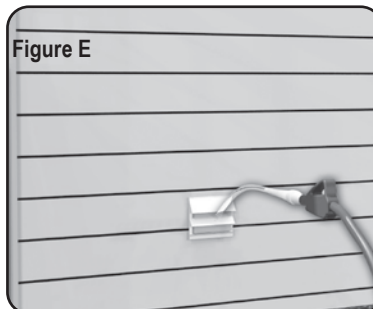
