Before you Start:

- This product should be assembled and used on firm, level ground. If used on unlevel ground, tipping may occur. Frame should remain in contact with the ground at all times.



CAUTION: Do not over tighten fasteners.

- Attach Seat (B) to Legs (A) by aligning holes in the leg crossbar with corresponding holes in the seat frame. Use the Hex Key (H) secure Screws (D), flat Washers (F) and Hex Nuts (G). Do not fully tighten fasteners.
- Slide Back (C) between Legs (A) and align holes. Insert Screws (E) through holes. Use the Hex Key
 secure Screws (E), flat Washers (F) and Hex Nuts (G). Insert Chain Screws (M8X70) through holes, secure with Washers (J) and Hex Nuts (K).
- 3. Insert Chain Screws (M8X50) through holes in the Legs (A).
- 4. Tighten all fasteners.

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
