Titanic Lesson:

In Musicplay 5, song #84 is The Ship Titanic. With all the coverage of the 100th anniversary of the Titanic disaster, this is a great week to teach the song

- 1. Have a discussion with your students to find out how much they already know about the disaster. Write a list of facts that they know on the board.
- 2. Listen to the recording of the song. I've posted the QuickTime Movie of the song on the Musicplay Facebook page http://www.facebook.com/#!/pages/Musicplay/129386630523431
- 3. Ask the students to tell you how many of the facts are probably accurate. (Were the lines on fire when the captain tried to wire?)
- 4. Discuss the mood of the song. Does the mood really fit with the scope of the tragedy that the song is about?
- 5. For students that are proficient recorder players, try to learn to play the theme song from the movie "Titanic" by ear, beginning on
