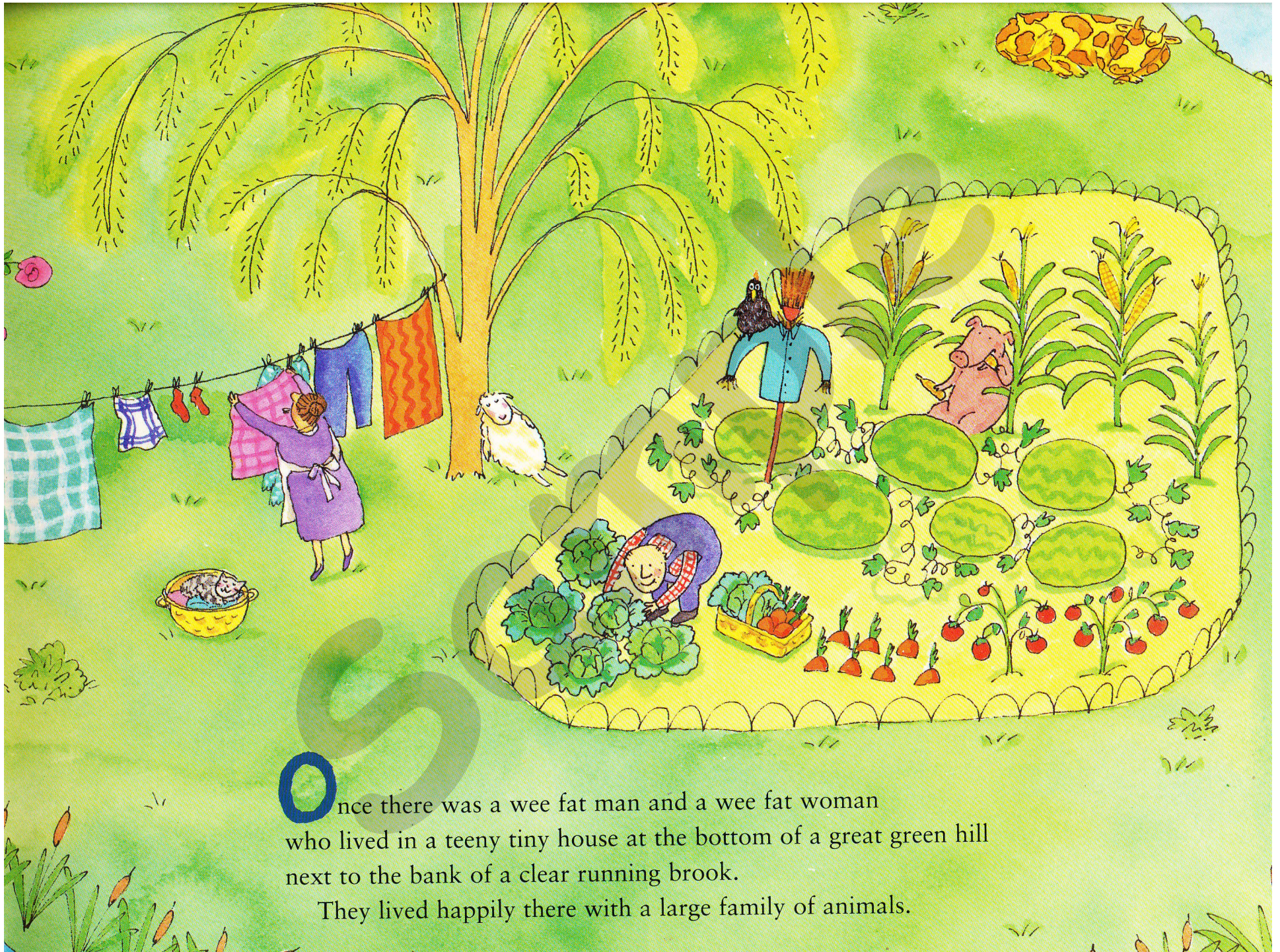




Is There Room
