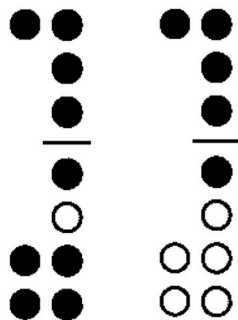

Soprano Fingerings:

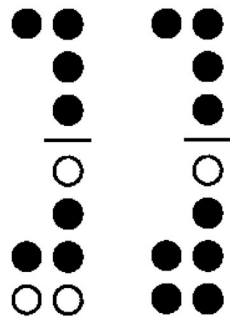
