


## RHYTHM DICE GAMES

Rhythm Dice Games has been written to give students practice in naming note values, rhythm reading and rhythm writing. Students from grade 3 and up will enjoy the games that are included in this kit.

It is suggested that the teacher begin with at least one of the worksheets as introduction or review. As the students learn the note names and values, use the worksheets to extend and reinforce their learning.

The games where students need to keep score are given as reproducibles. The teacher is permitted to make as many copies as needed for the classes in one school. We've included 6 sets of the games with gameboards (Race Track and Scales and Snakes) on colored colored cardstock for the teacher to laminate and use. If additional gameboards are needed, the teacher is permitted to copy these as well for the classes in one school. The kit comes with 20 dice so that you can pair up your students and everyone can play. Extra dice are available for purchase.
