After Exposure to Biological Hazards the Radio and Safer Strap® requires Decontamination.

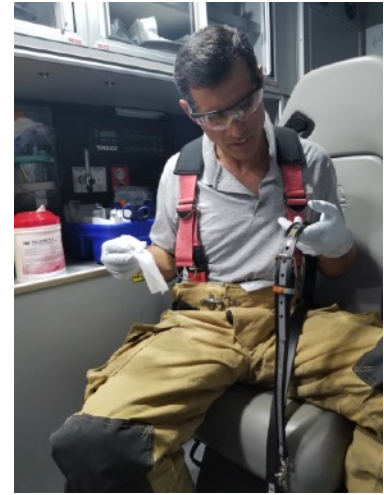

Once the Radio has been removed and Decontaminated, the Safer Strap® should be thoroughly wiped with an appropriate Biocide/ Cavicide wipe while utilizing universal precautions.

Wipe under all hardware and keepers to remove all contamination. Utilize new wipes as necessary.
