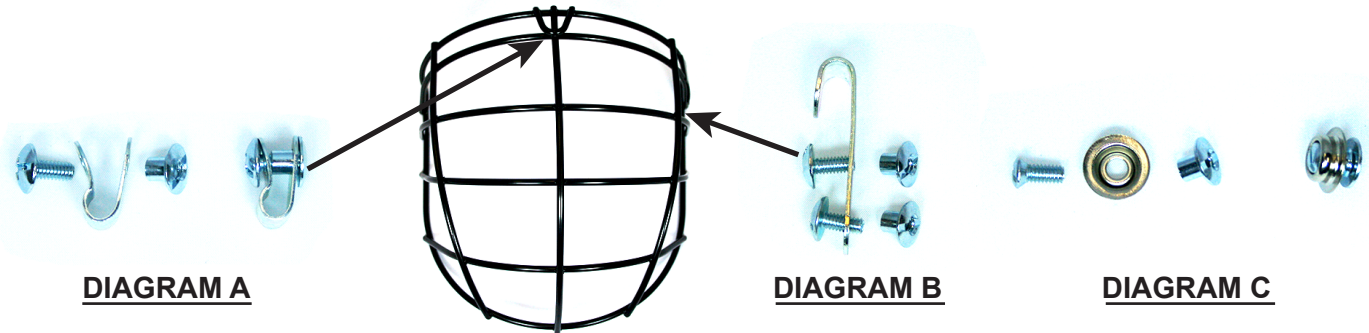

 N-3 NAMI SENIOR LACROSSE (TYPE B).....BAUER BHH5500-L / RBK HT4K-L

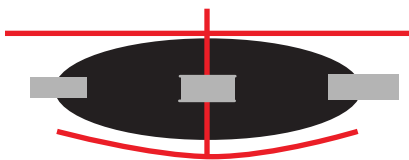


**TO FIT MASK TO HELMET**

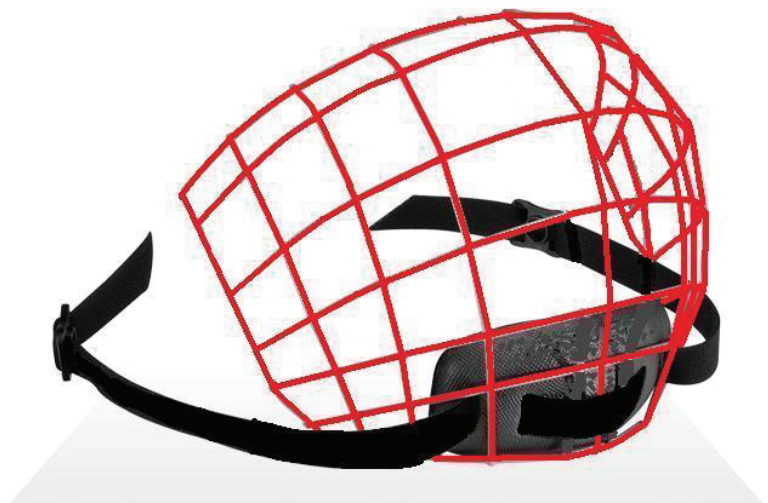
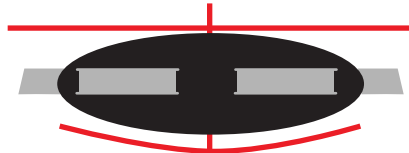
1. With helmet properly fitted to head, place front clips on cage and place cage in position on helmet, bending cage slightly if required to fit helmet.
2. Fasten cage to helmet with enclosed screws and washers as per (DIAGRAM A)
3. With helmet and cage in proper position, attach side bracket (DIAGRAM B) to helmet.
4. Where applicable, snap two buckles of the side straps on domes located at the back of the helmet. Adjust the side buckles to hold mask securely (DIAGRAM C).

**FITTING CHIN CUP TO MASK**
