


Unbox your speakers and check that you have the following parts:

Quick Start (continued)

Position your speakers as desired and locate the nearest mains power outlet to the speakers. The active speaker may go on the left or the right – it does not matter at this stage.

Connect the active speaker to the passive speaker using the 4-way speaker connection cable. Tighten the locking nut being careful not to cross the threads – if it does not screw on easily, please loosen it and start again!

Locate the switch labelled 'L MONO R' on the rear of the active speaker. If the active speaker is on the left side, select 'L'; if it is on the Right side, select 'R'. If the speaker is to be used on its own as a mono speaker, select 'MONO'.

You may choose at this stage to connect your speaker to the network using an Ethernet cable. This is not a requirement as Wi-Fi may be configured later. However, using Ethernet cables to connect your speakers to the router may result in better network performance for your other applications.

Turn on the power switch on the rear of the active speaker – a RED light will illuminate on the front of the active speaker.


Press the 'Power' button on the remote control, or alternatively short-press the 'Volume / Input' knob at the rear of the active speaker. The RED light will flash indicating that the speaker is initialising.

Once the speaker initialisation is complete, the active speaker will display a WHITE light showing that it is on, and the network input is selected.

If you have used an Ethernet cable to connect your speaker to the network, then setup is now complete, however you may wish to read the StreamQ App section of the manual to see how to change the name of your speaker. If you wish to use Wi-Fi, please refer to the following instructions relevant to your mobile device / Network:

Power on your speaker and wait for a white light indicating it has finished its initialisation.

Press the WPS button on your Router (see your router's instruction manual for help). You now typically have up-to 2 minutes to go to the speaker and press the WPS button.

Once the WPS setup process has completed you will be able to access your speaker and play music on it using either the StreamQ app, or other music streaming service app.

You may find it useful to rename your speaker – instructions for doing this can be found in the 'Installing and using the StreamQ app' section of this manual. When choosing a speaker name, you may find it helpful to call the speaker by the name of the room it is in if you have a number of speakers on your network – for example 'Master Bedroom' or 'Living Room'.

Configuring your speaker from Android

Power on your speaker and wait for a white light indicating it has finished its initialisation.

Swipe down from the top of the screen and choose to search for a new wifi network. Select your new speaker from the list of available wifi networks.

Open a web browser and navigate to www.bayanaudio.com/setup

You will be prompted for a name for the speaker – typically we recommend naming the speaker by the name of the room the speaker is located in (e.g. kitchen, living room, bedroom).

Next you will need to select the name of the Wi-Fi network to which you wish to connect the speaker from the 'Network Name' drop down selection box. If your network is not listed, please check the router is turned on, and that your android device is connected to it. You can refresh the list of networks if necessary.

Enter the 'Password' for your Wi-Fi network – you may find this written on the bottom of your Wi-Fi router unless you have changed the password at some point.

Tap 'Connect' and wait for a message saying 'You are connected'.

Your speaker will now connect to your Wi-Fi and is ready to use.

Configuring your speaker from iOS

Open Settings, Wi-Fi, then select your new speaker. You will now be asked to choose the name for your speaker – you may find it helpful to call the speaker by the name of the room it is in if you have a number of speakers on your network – for example 'Master Bedroom' or 'Living Room'

Next you will need to select the name of the Wi-Fi network to which you wish to connect the speaker from the 'Network Name' drop down selection box. If your network is not listed, please check the router is turned on, and that your android device is connected to it. You can refresh the list of networks if necessary.

Enter the 'Password' for your Wi-Fi network – you may find this written on the bottom of your Wi-Fi router unless you have changed the password at some point.

Tap 'Connect' and wait for a message saying 'You are connected'.

Configuring your speaker from Windows and OSX

In the notification area of the Taskbar, right click on the Wi-Fi logo, and connect to your new speaker (Note – your computer may tell you that you have 'Limited Access')

Open your web browser, and try to connect to a web page – you will be taken to the web interface of the speaker and asked to give the speaker a name - you may find it helpful to call the speaker by the name of the room it is in if you have a number of speakers on your network – for example 'Master Bedroom' or 'Living Room'

Next you will need to select the name of the Wi-Fi network to which you wish to connect the speaker from the 'Network Name' drop down selection box. If your network is not listed, please check the router is turned on, and that your android device is connected to it. You can refresh the list of networks if necessary.

Enter the 'Password' for your Wi-Fi network – you may find this written on the bottom of your Wi-Fi router unless you have changed the password at some point.

Tap 'Connect' and wait for a message saying 'You are connected'.

Your speaker will now connect to your Wi-Fi and is ready to use.



Remote Control



Power

Wake speakers from standby or put to sleep



Mute

Silence the speakers until mute is pressed again



Bluetooth

Disconnect any Bluetooth devices currently connected to the speaker, and allow new devices to pair.



Rewind

Press and hold to seek, short press to skip back one track



Play/Pause

Press to start or pause the music



FFWD

Press and hold to seek, short press to skip forward one track.



Line In

Selects the AUX line in connection as the current input



WiFi

Selects network mode for wifi / Ethernet multiroom streaming of music



OPT

Selects the optical in connection as the current input



DOWN



Power

This is the main power on / off switch for the loudspeaker



Internet

Used to connect your speaker to the network using an RJ45 Ethernet cable (where Wi-Fi signal is weak or not available, or for best performance)



L Aux

connect the left channel of auxiliary equipment such as CD players here



R Aux

connect the right channel of auxiliary equipment such as CD players here



Optical

connect digital audio inputs such as the optical output from your TV here



100-240V 50-60HZ

mains power connector



Speaker out

connect the passive speaker here using the supplied 4-way speaker connection cable.

Connecting your speaker to other equipment

Bluetooth

Select the Bluetooth input either with the remote control or by short pressing the Volume / Input knob to the rear of the product.

Your speaker will automatically connect to the last Bluetooth audio source it was used with (if available) – if not you will be able to search for it and pair in the normal way

Bluetooth Pairing

You can use Bluetooth Secure Simple Pairing to connect and stream music:

To enter pairing mode, press and hold the Bluetooth Pairing button on the remote control.

Consult your audio source user manual for instructions on how to pair with Bluetooth devices – generally you will need to go into your settings, Bluetooth, scan for new Bluetooth devices and select your speaker. You will not be prompted for a passcode for pairing.

Note

For secure simple pairing to work your MP3 /phone / tablet / laptop must be in close proximity to the speaker when trying to pair (within a range of 1 metre)

After pairing is successful, paired devices will remember each other – unless pairing information is deleted there is no need to carry out pairing again. Your speaker can remember the last 4 audio sources that it was paired with, and will automatically connect to the last audio source it was connected to (if it is in range).

If you want to connect to an alternate audio source, press the pairing button on the remote control to disconnect it from the current audio source and enable pairing mode.

Pairing with NFC

If your Android device supports NFC, you can use this to quickly and easily pair your Bluetooth connection.

First, turn on your android device and unlock the screen (ensuring that NFC is enabled in the settings)

Next, Touch the back of your audio source to the back cover of the remote control for your Silverpoint Speaker.
(Note – if you have multiple Silverpoint Speakers, you will need to remember which remote goes with which speaker, as the NFC chips in the remotes are individually coded to the speaker during manufacture).

Finally, confirm that you wish to connect and pair with your speaker

You can now connect and disconnect by simply touching your audio source at any time to the back of the remote.

Controlling the volume for Bluetooth music

There are 2 volume controls available to adjust how loud your music is playing back – on the audio source itself, and on the speaker. You will not be able to get maximum volume unless the volume is turned up to maximum both on the audio source, and the speaker.

For optimum sound quality we suggest turning the volume to near maximum on your audio source, and then using the volume control on your speaker (rear knob or remote control) to adjust the volume output to your desired listening level.

Optical

Ensure that your audio source is connected via an Optical (S/PDif) cable to the rear of the active speaker, and is switched on.

Select the Optical input either with the remote control or by short pressing the Volume / Input knob to the rear of the product.

Auxiliary

Ensure that your audio source is connected via a stereo RCA lead to the rear of the active speaker, and is switched on and playing music.

Select the Auxiliary input either with the remote control or by short pressing the Volume / Input knob to the rear of the product. You should now hear your music playing.

Controlling the volume for Auxiliary source music

There are 2 volume controls available to adjust how loud your music is playing back – on the audio source itself, and on the speaker. You will not be able to get maximum volume unless the volume is turned up to maximum both on the audio source, and the speaker.

For optimum sound quality we suggest turning the volume to near maximum on your audio source, and then using the volume control on your speaker (rear knob or remote control) to adjust the volume output to your desired listening level.

Installing the StreamQ App

Android Installation

Launch the Play Store on your Android device and search for 'Bayan StreamQ', the official Bayan App which has this icon:

Troubleshooting



What File Formats can I stream to the Speakers from the StreamQ App?

StreamQ supports MP3, AAC, AAC+, FLAC, WAV, ALAC and PCM file formats up to 192KHz sampling rate and 24 bit resolution.

Updating the Speaker Firmware

From time to time new firmware will be released for the speakers to add new functionality. This can be downloaded and updated easily over the internet.

To check for firmware updates, make sure your speakers are connected to the Wi-Fi / Ethernet and that there is an internet connection. In the App go to the Main Menu and select Speaker Settings. Choose the speaker you wish to update, and select 'Check for update'.

By default, the 'Auto updated' feature is disabled – this is to ensure that there is no interruption to your listening.

During a firmware update, do not un-plug or turn off the speakers. The lights on the front of the speakers will flash and the speaker may restart several times.

Once the speaker has restarted and is available in the App for music playback, the update has completed.

How can I Factory Reset / Hard Reset the Speaker?

Occasionally you may need to perform a factory reset on one of your speakers. This may be because you have changed your Router, your Wi-Fi SSID or your Wi-Fi Password, and your speaker is no longer connected to the network.

Performing a factory reset enables you to reconnect to your speaker from your mobile device and then configure the network as described in the Quick Start section of this user guide.

Troubleshooting (contd)

To perform a factory reset, turn on your speaker and wait for the RED light to stop flashing (indicating it has completed its initialisation)

At the rear of the speaker, locate the button labelled 'WIFI MODE'. Press and hold this button for 5 seconds, then let go. The RED light at the front will flash as the speaker restarts.

Once the RED light has stopped flashing, your speaker has been factory reset and is ready for network configuration – see the Quick Start section of this user guide.
