

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Chase Harper USA luggage is constructed from high quality industrial grade ballistic nylon that is treated to repel water, dirt and stains, which makes cleaning easy. Clean with mild soap and light-pressure water using a nylon-bristled brush or microfiber cloth. For best results, clean the entire bag, not just the soiled area. Stubborn stains may be treated with Simple Green®, Fantastik®, Woolite®, 409®, or similar cleaning product. Foaming upholstery cleaners made for wool-nylon blend fabrics also work well. After your fabric has been cleaned, spray with Scotchgard® to maintain water, dirt and stain resistance properties. *Note: When using any commercial cleaning product, follow the manufacturer's directions carefully.

WARRANTY INFORMATION

For peace of mind we offer a lifetime warranty on all of our products. If you need to claim against the warranty, please contact us and we'll guide you through the process. Be advised sun damage is not covered under the warranty.

When sending an item in for repair, please wash the bag prior to shipping. If the item arrives dirty, a \$20 cleaning fee may be applied to the repair. Also, be sure to include a note with the item that states the damage description along with your contact information including phone number, email, and return shipping address so we can send updates on your repair.

950 TANK BAG MAGNETIC MOUNT MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

Inspect underside of the magnetic 'wings' to ensure they are free of foreign metal objects that may cause scratching or damage

Place tank bag onto motorcycle tank in a location that will not interfere with a safe riding position

Attach the safety strap using the included hardware by following the steps below:

- 1. Wrap keeper safety strap around motorcycle steering head
- (Optional) Feed both ends of the keeper safety strap down through the narrow end of the teardrop tank protector and then bring both ends back up through the broad end of the teardrop tank protector
- 3. Unclip male connection of ladder lock buckle from rubber sleeve located at the back of the tank bag
- Feed both ends of the keeper safety strap up and through ladder lock buckle. Clip male connection of ladder lock buckle back into female connection at the back of the tank bag then tighten for secure fit

*Helpful hint: Excess ends of the keeper safety strap can be tucked back into the teardrop tank protector or trimmed for a cleaner appearance after install.
