

# CUSTOM ULTIMATE SPORTS WALL ART PHOTO GUIDELINES

## Getting started

It's important to check your image resolution before you upload your image. Our team wants to ensure your photo will look as amazing printed on the final Wall Art as it appears on your phone or computer screen.

## How to check your image resolution

Simply open your image and zoom in to at least 300% magnification. If it appears crisp at that enlarged view, then your artwork is most likely print-ready. If your artwork appears pixelated (jagged or blurry), it's low resolution and might not be ideal for large format printing.

## How to fix image resolution issues

What if your resolution is too low for high-quality printing? For some photos, we have the digital capability to enhance the resolution of your original image for large format printing. However, we'll still require the best quality photo possible at the outset to even consider that process.

## Additional tips

Ideally, the photos you provide should include an unobstructed view of the subject (no other props or players in the foreground) in order to seamlessly remove the background. See the first 2 images below. If not, alternate design approaches can be used showing a partial figure.



## Upload your photo

In order to feature crisp graphics, sharp definition and beautiful color depth, proper image resolution is critical to printing our stunning Wall Art. Be sure to use a clear, high quality image to get the best results.
