Breed and Description - PULLETS	Price	QTY
Araucanas: Lay a light blue or green egg. These birds vary in color and size.	\$3.45	
Barred Rocks: Lays Brown eggs. These birds are black with white striped feathers.	\$3.45	
Black Australorps: Lays Brown eggs. These birds are black with a green sheen.	\$3.45	
Black Giants: Black bird that lays brown eggs. They are very docile.	\$3.45	
Black Sex Link: Cross between RIR male and Barred Rock hen. Lays brown eggs.	\$3.45	
Brahmas: Generally docile birds. They have feathered leg shanks and lay Brown eggs.	\$3.45
