



SETTING THE TIME * Before setting the time, check that the chronograph measurement is stopped.

Turn the crown clockwise until the previous day's date appears. 3) Pull out the crown to the second click when the second hand is at the 12 o'clock position. It will stop on the spot. Set the hands to the desired time of the day (make sure AM/PM is set correctly) by turning the crown clockwise. The date will move forward to the current date once you rotate the hands

When the crown is at the second click position, do not press any button. Otherwise the chronograph hands will move out of the zero position. 4) Once the current time is set, push the crown back in the normal

* The stopwatch can measure up to 60 minutes.
