Grainfather Camlock Conversion Guide

- 1. CUT THE Recirculation Pipe: Use a hacksaw to cut off the end off the Grainfather Recirculation Pipe, smoothing any burrs with a wire brush or file.
- 2. INSTALL THE COMPRESSION FITTING: Press the unthreaded end of the Compression Fitting firmly onto your just cut Grainfather Recirculation Pipe, making sure it is seated before tightening with two wrenches.
- 3. INSTALL THE ARM CAMLOCK: Screw the Male Camlock Fitting onto the now threaded Grainfather Recirculation Pipe and tighten.
- 4. INSTALL THE FEMALE CAMIOCK: Screw the 3/8" by 1/2" Reducing Bush onto the top of the valve body, and then screw in the Female Camlock.
- 5. MODIFY THE CHILLER: Cut the threaded fitting off the end of the silicone tubing on the chiller and then press the Hose Barb Male Camlock into the tubing and secure with a clamp. You are done.
