

SINGING SANDS

Singing Sands Road, Comox

Skill level: Advanced.

Access: Parking for a half a dozen cars, and a short 10 meter walk to the

water across a pebble beach.

Dive: This dive must be timed with slack tide, currents are strong here so always take an SMB on your dive, and don't surface away from the shore. Descend near the beach and head due north until you reach a small yacht at around 70 foot depth. The 30 foot long wreck is the only feature at this dive and can be easy to miss.

What to see: A great place to see octopus, rockfish and anemones.

Tips: Because this is a deeper dive, we recommend using Nitrox. Diving with a buddy that has knowledge of this site is strongly recommended.

Note: There is a BC Ferry terminal to the left of the dive site. Ferry traffic is loud and does come close to shore. Caution is recommended. This is also a residential area, so please keep noise to a minimum. We do not encourage hunting at this site.
