

TYEE COVE

Blueback Community Park, Nanoose Bay

Skill level: All divers.

Access: Tye Cove has parking for half a dozen cars, with a portable toilet, changing room, and picnic table. Easy access to water with small slope. There is a defined pathway into the water on the far right of the beach, avoiding shallow rocks.

Dive: There are two dives at this site. Right wall: descend at any point and follow the gradient to the right. Explore the wall at depth, before turning and making your way back shallower. Left wall: a deeper dive that has nice sponges.

What to see: Wolf eel, rockfish, perch, tube snout, nudibranchs, brittle stars.

Tips: A great site if you are new to the area, trying out gear, require an easy entry, or just want a nice easy dive. Keep an eye open for stubby squid, and the occasional octopus where the sand meets the wall.

Note: This is a residential area, so please keep noise to a minimum. We do not encourage hunting at this site.
