2016 Crognolo—James Suckling 95 Pts—Bright ruby red. Complex with a prevalence of small red fruits & floral notes. The body is beautifully balanced with a long finish.\$23.95

2018 Chateau Val-Joanis Rosé (Rhone)—A lively, fresh & aromatic wine with notes of red berries & citrus fruit. Perfect for the pool or beach!\$9.95

Terry's Pick of the Month

NV Domaine J. Laurens Cremant de Limoux Brut—Rich yeasty aromas & flavors along with vibrant lemon citrus, yellow apple & pineapple. On the palate, nice & fresh with spicy notes.\$12.95



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AUSTRALIA

2017 Torbreck Woodcutter's Shiraz—Wine Spectator 93 Pts—Aromatic blackberries & raspberries with freshness & balance, the wine has a round central core of red fruit that gives way to a complex mid-palate full of cassis, dark cherry, spice & vanilla. \$17.95
2016 Glaetzer Wallace Shiraz/Grenache—Robert Parker 91 Pts—Deep gamet. Hints of red currant, clove & spice. Fresh juiciness combines with supple tannin & pronounced flavors of licorice & mulberry.\$19.95
2016 Glaetzer Bishop—Australian Wine Companion 95 Pts—Deep crimson-purple; a complex wine, both in terms of its savory flavors & its texture. Black fruits provide the core of the palate, with graphite, earth & tannins all on parade.\$27.95

2015 Domaines Lupier La Dama—Robert Parker 96 Points—Bright ruby. Harmonious & nicely textured with chalky tannins & a stony sensation.\$39.95
2016 Clos Erasmus "Laurel"—95 Jeb Dunnock—This deep purple-colored beauty offers up a fresh, vibrant bouquet of blueberries, crisp plums, violets, and spring flowers. Possessing full-bodied richness, beautiful depth of fruit & richness, and a fresh, elegant style!\$39.95



WHITE BURGUNDY

2017 J.J. Vincent Bourgogne Blanc—Clean pale yellow color & green reflections. The nose is fresh & fruity, ripe & round with discrete vanilla & brioche scents. On the mouth, the wine is dense & rich, fresh & subtle with a good length & finesse. Overall, the wine is nicely balanced, fresh, elegant & with a long finish.\$14.95
2016 Latour Montagny Les Buys—Pretty aromas of white fruits & muscat-like notes on the nose. It is ample & round on the palate with aromas of marzipan. Nice minerality on the finish.\$16.95
2016 Latour Montagny La Grande Roche 1er Cru—James Suckling 92 Pts—Shows a pale yellow color with bright reflections. The nose is very floral with aromas of honeysuckle & white hawthorn. Ample in the mouth, of a beautiful roundness, notes of white fruits appear with a peppery finish.\$20.95


2016 Argiano Non Confunditur—James Suckling 93 Pts— Beautiful on the nose, showing lots of brambly notes, ranging from undergrowth & forest floor to elderberries, raspberry bush & dried herbs. Full-bodied, tight & very elegant, framed by linear tannins & bright acidity. **\$14.95**

2016 Petrolo Torrone —James Suckling 95 Pts—Aromas of dried flowers, dried berries, cherries & hints of stones. Full-bodied, very firm & silky. An intense underlying energy of acidity & a lovely finish. **\$22.95**

2016 Petrolo Boggina A—Robert Parker 96 Pts—This is elegant, offering cherry, plum, tobacco, leather & earth flavors, backed by lively acidity. Harmonious & long, echoing the leather & tobacco elements, with a hint of mineral. **\$39.95**

2016 Petrolo Boggina C—James Suckling 96 Pts—This vibrant, balanced red is rich, with plum, cherry, iron & tobacco notes. Firms up nicely, suggesting a decade or more of development ahead, ending with a tangy aftertaste of fruit & mineral. **\$39.95**

2015 Argiano Solengo—James Suckling 97 Pts—Fantastic aromas of flowers such as violets & roses with dark purple fruits & hints of stones, too. Full body with ultra-fine tannins & a long, linear finish. **\$69.95**



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CABS & BLENDS

2017 Chappellet Mountain Cuvee—Offers a complex array of elegant aromas that include spicy red fruit, black cherry, sage, anise, clove & cocoa powder. Flavors of red currant & cassis are underscored by hints of smoke & vanilla, while seamlessly integrated tannins add length & structure to this complex blend of Bordeaux varietals. **\$28.95**

2016 Stonestreet Estate—Jeb Dunnuck/Antonio Galloni 93 Pts—Starts out with savory aromas of blackberry, dark plum, blood orange, star anise & black cherry. As the wine opens, deep fruit flavors of blackberry cobbler, dried cherry, pomegranate, cassis & milk chocolate begin to show. The palate is rich & inviting with framed tannins, incredible length & good concentration. **\$34.95**

2015 Gamble—Antonio Galloni 94 Pts—Ripe, exuberant & flamboyant in style, the 2015 offers plenty of the vintage's raciness & yet manages to do so without being overbearing. Crème de cassis, plum, licorice, chocolate, spice & menthol build effortlessly in the glass. **\$44.95**

2014 Wolf's Head—Jeb Dunnuck 96 Pts—Has a kiss of sweet oak as well as beautiful creme de cassis fruit & spice to go with a medium to full-bodied, beautifully balanced feel on the palate. **\$47.95**

2016 Teeter Totter—Jeb Dunnuck 95 Pts—This beauty boasts a saturated purple color as well as a classic bouquet of crème de cassis, licorice, toasted spices & tobacco. Deep, full-bodied & powerful, it still has the class & purity of the 2016 vintage front & center. **\$51.95**

SUMMER WHITES

2018 Domaine Tariquet—This dry, fruity wine boasts magnificent intensity & lovely open floral & citrus scents, with a delightfully exotic feel. A bracing, crisp wine with great freshness in the mouth & slightly salty finish. **\$7.50**

2016 Colome Torrontes—Decanter 91 Pts—A light, refreshing wine with Muscat notes redolent of jasmine & orange blossoms. **\$8.95**

2016 Arona Sauvignon Blanc—Orange peel & melon aromas. The palate offers balanced acidity with spice & lemon peel tones. **\$9.95**

2018 Font Mars Picpoul—A fresh & youthful, lemon & pear drop scented wine. Light & delicate with fresh citrus fruit flavors, green apple, touches of honey & lychee. Good concentration of flavor & crisp acidity. **\$10.95**

2016 Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio—Straw yellow color. Clean intense aroma. Dry golden apple taste. Full of authentic, flavorful personality. **\$16.95**

2018 Dominique Crochet Sancerre—Pale golden in color. A crisp, mineral aroma with hints of pear, stone fruits & citrusy notes. Fresh, crisp with a great minerality. **\$17.95**

2017 Chalk Hill Sauvignon Blanc—Wine Spectator 92 Pts—Bright, tropical aromas of grapefruit, lime blossom, passion-fruit & plumeria flower. The palate is crisp & refreshing with flavors of nectar, grapefruit zest, honeydew melon & lime juice. It finishes with a rich texture & mouthwatering minerality. **\$19.95**



ROSÉ WINES

2018 Campuget (Costieres de Nimes)—Light, fresh pink color. Fruity taste of raspberries & strawberries, typical of the Campuget style. Good & refreshing acidity. **\$9.95**

2018 Routas (Provence)—James Suckling 93 Pts—Freshly cut watermelon, ripe peach aromas & floral notes lead to a palate alive with wild strawberries & hints of mineral notes. Crisp acidity & a refreshing finish. **\$11.95**

2018 Chateau de Manissy Tavel (Rhône Valley)—40 year old, organic vines. Light, bright, subtle, dry, "Provence style" Rose. Strawberries, citrus & light spice & dry wild herbs sing in harmony. Finishes light, juicy & tangy with a kick of black pepper & wild strawberry. **\$14.95**



2018 Domaine du Vieux College Marsannay (Burgundy)—Pink color with salmon reflections. Elegant & fresh. Fruity, floral & spicy, with a distinct note of white peach. Supple & lively. **\$17.95**

2018 Whispering Angel (Provence)—James Suckling 92 Pts—Fresh red berry fruit characteristics with a floral nose. Ripe & fleshy feel on the palate. Great concentration. Smooth & round finish. **\$19.95**

2018 Meyer Nakel (Germany)—100% Pinot Noir. Pale ruby color. Bouquet of ripe bing cherry & white pepper. Beautifully expressive palate with flavors of honeycrisp apple, crushed rocks, tart raspberry & clove. **\$20.95**
