INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing KEC-2218. Please read and follow the instructions in this manual carefully to ensure your product operates correctly.

General Features

- Efficient & rapid boiling
- Food grade SUS304 stainless steel body and interior
- Easy grip ergonomic handle
- Rear water level indicator
- Cordless 360° power base with cord winder for easy storage
- Concealed heating elements; dry boil protection
- Capacity : 1.7L ; Power : 2500-3000W

HOW TO OPERATE

Boiling

1. Lift the kettle, pull off the lid.
2. Fill the kettle with water (Do not exceed the " MAX " line).
3. Close and push the lid downward to make sure it is locked.
4. Connect the Power Base to the power source, and place kettle on the Power Base.
5. Push the [ON/OFF] switch downward to " - ", kettle starts boiling, and the Power Indicator turns on.
6. When boiling completes, power is turned off automatically ([ON/OFF] switch returns to " O ").

Stop Boiling

1. Push [ON/OFF] switch upward to " O " to cut power off when boiling.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

1. Do not switch the kettle on with insufficient or no water inside.
2. The Dry Boil Protection function will automatically shut power off if the kettle is dry boiled. To reset the Dry Boil Protection function, lift the kettle from its base and fill it with cold water. You can use it again now.
3. Do not fill the kettle beyond the MAX indication. Overfilling may cause hot water to spill out, resulting in scalds, short circuit, electric shock or malfunction.
4. Disconnect the Power Base from the power source when not using the kettle.
5. Do not use the kettle if the Power Plug or Power Cord is damaged, or if the Power Plug is loosely inserted into the electrical outlet.
6. Close the Lid securely to prevent hot water from spilling out.
7. Do not immerse the kettle in water, splash it with water or wash the entire unit. Doing so may otherwise cause short circuit, electric shock or malfunction.
8. Do not boil any other liquids besides water.
9. Do not touch hot surfaces to avoid scalds. Hold the kettle by the handle.
10. Keep the kettle away from children to avoid any possible risk.
