



4 Create Your Signature Item




5 Build Your Team

Teams are one of the most important parts of a business. Who is going to help you make your business a success? Choose different people so no one has to do two jobs!




Founder

Your name goes here because this is your business!




Chief of Staff or General Manager

Who is the person who always helps you do everything?




Executive Chef or Food Manager

Who is the best chef you know (or one you don't know but look up to!)




Server or Customer Service
