



SPECIFICATIONS

- Solid wood products are made from 100% FSC-certified wood from European forestry.
- For oiled wood surfaces a pure, solvent-free hard oil is used. This surface treatment fulfils: DIN 68861/1C (chemical stress on furniture surfaces), EN 71-3 (migration of soluble heavy metals).
- Coloured and clear lacquers used on wood and composite materials are matt, lightfast, water-thinnable and based on an acrylic binder. This surface treatment fulfils: DIN 68861/1B (chemical exposure of furniture surfaces), EN 71-3 (migration of soluble heavy metals), DIN 53160 (part 1 and 2 saliva and perspiration fastness).
















TRANSPARENCY
