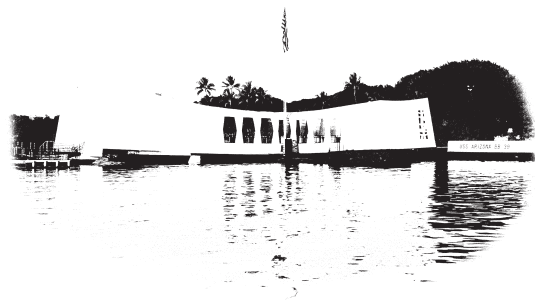


# How to experience the USS Arizona Memorial



## ★ Advance Tickets

Each day 325 tickets to the Memorial are placed online 60 days in advance at recreation.gov.

## ★ Next Day Tickets

Each day an additional 525 tickets are placed online to the Memorial, the day before your arrival, on recreation.gov.

Recreation.gov is the National Park Service's website for all their Parks' reservations.

Tickets are made available each day at 7 a.m. *Hawaii Standard Time* and can be booked online or by calling, toll-free, 1-877-444-6777.

When booking online, please search for "Pearl Harbor Historic Sites" on the home page of recreation.gov.

The online reservation system includes the movie/boat ticket to the Memorial and offers three options:

1. USS *Arizona* Memorial movie/boat ticket only. Select the date and number of tickets you desire. There's a \$1.00 reservation fee per ticket.
2. For a more enriching Pearl Harbor experience, book the National Park Service USS *Arizona* Memorial Narrated Tour, available in nine languages. This incredible two-hour self-guided tour is just \$7.50 and is hosted by Jamie Lee Curtis and many of the Pearl Harbor survivors.
3. For the full experience, book the Pearl Harbor Historic Sites' Passport to Pearl Harbor, offering all the Pearl Harbor sites at a discounted price.
4. Upgrade your Narrated Tour to the Deluxe Tour for access to the National Park Service archives.

Visitors must check in at least one hour prior to the departure ticket time or the tickets may be reassigned. Reservations are restricted to six tickets per day, per credit card.

## ★ Walk-in Tickets

If you are unable to secure reservations, each morning the National Park Service gives out an additional 1,300 free walk-up USS *Arizona* Memorial tickets at the Pearl Harbor Visitor Center, on a first-come, first-served basis. Visitors who want these tickets should arrive at the Visitor Center early. The gate opens at 7 a.m. The entire family or group has to be present at the Visitor Center to qualify for these free tickets.



## ★ Other Options

### 1. Daily standby tickets to the Memorial are available!

There are occasionally no-shows for the tour to the Memorial. Visitors are welcome to stand by for the tours at the Pearl Harbor Visitor Center Theater.

### 2. Experience the *Arizona* Memorial through the National Park Service's new virtual reality tour!

At the Visitor Center, the new Pearl Harbor Virtual Reality Center is open daily from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. and offers three incredible VR tours for just \$4.95. The most popular VR tour is called "Experience the USS *Arizona* Memorial," which is so detailed and realistic that you can actually read every name in the shrine room and have the ability to explore the entire Memorial, including an unbelievable visit on top of the Memorial for a 360-degree view of historic Pearl Harbor.

## USS *Arizona* Memorial Shuttle

The first USS *Arizona* Memorial tour begins at 7:30 a.m. and runs every 15 minutes to 3 p.m. Each tour takes approximately 75 minutes. Boats are operated by the U.S. Navy and hold 145 passengers each.



## Pearl Harbor Visitor Center

The Pearl Harbor Visitor Center is open daily from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (closed Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's). Admission and parking is free. Please be advised that the Visitor Center has a no-bag policy; visitors can bring their wallets, cameras, cellular phones and water.

## USS *Arizona* Memorial Museum Store

Discover the largest selection of WWII in the Pacific books and memorabilia in the USS *Arizona* Memorial Museum Store, conveniently located at the entrance of the Pearl Harbor Visitor Center. Open daily from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
