SAFETY INFORMATION

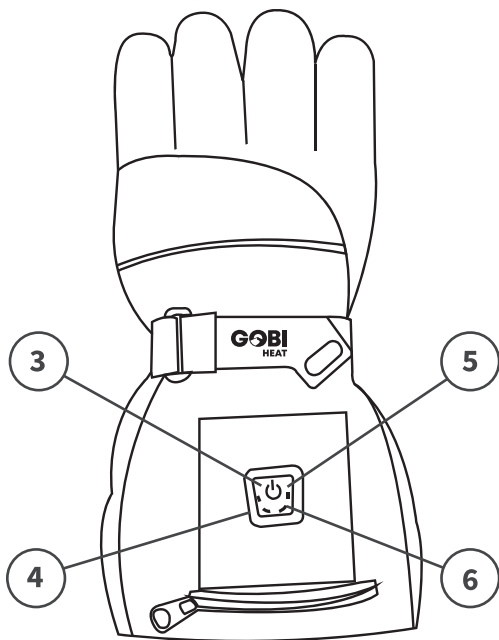
- Infants; children; persons requiring close supervision; or anyone insensitive to heat, such as a person with poor circulation, should not use this product.
- Never use if inner lining is wet.
- Heating elements should not be allowed to touch bare skin
- Shut off power immediately if discomfort occurs.
- Do not allow the cords to be pinched.
- Discontinue use of this product if it stops working correctly or heats inconsistently.
- Do not use pins on or around this jacket as they can cause damage to the wiring.
- Remove the battery pack from the battery pocket before washing. Be sure to secure the connector into the battery pocket before washing.

- Do not dry clean. Do not use dry-cleaning fluid on this item. Do not bleach. Cleaning solvents may have a detrimental effect on the insulation of the heating elements.
- Do not iron.
- Do not remove sewn in labels. These carry important information.
- The device may interfere with other electronic devices such as pacemakers and more. Consult with your doctor before use.
- Do not use if you have impaired temperature sensitivity. Consult with your doctor before use.
- Keep the product out of the reach of small children, as it contains small parts which could be easily swallowed.
- Always turn off the device and disconnect the batteries when it is not in use.
- This item should be serviced by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts.

HEATED SKI GLOVES

1. Charge the glove batteries until the charging light turns green. The charging time of a completely discharged battery is usually 4-6 hours.
2. Carefully connect the charged batteries to the gloves.

6. 4 small LED lights on the button indicate the remaining battery life.

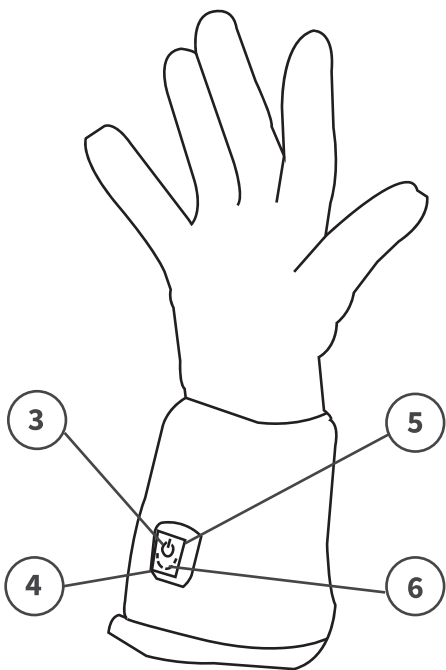
