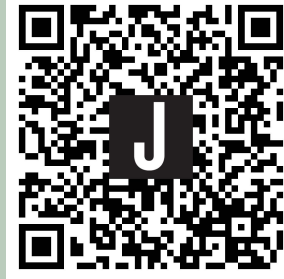
Jesmonite AC100 Starter Kit



If this is your first time using Jesmonite then you are in good hands. Jesmonite is a non-toxic acrylic resin & mineral system. It was originally designed as a building material and has become popular in the craft industry to make decorative creations.

Create your
own coasters!

4 squares
or
6 hexagons



Getting Started

Step 1

Weigh out Jesmonite liquid and powders.



Square mould: Weigh out 56g of liquid and 144g of Jesmonite base.

Hexagon mould: Weigh 36g of liquids and 90g of Jesmonite base.

Step 2

Slowly mix Jesmonite liquid and base together until smooth and free from lumps.



Top Tip - Scrape around the sides to check you get all the powder.

Step 3

Time for some colour!
Add a small amount of pigment. Beware, if you add too much pigment, it will stop the Jesmonite from setting and make the cast weak.



Top Tip - Once you have your mixture, it will begin to set within 5 minutes, make sure to move onto the next step right away.

Step 4

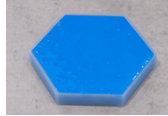
Pour the mixture into the mould until level.



Top Tip - Air can get trapped in your finished creations. Gently tap the sides of the mould after pouring, whilst the mixture is still liquid.

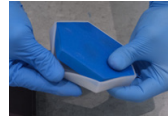
Step 5

Leave your creation to set for two hours in a cool dry place.



Step 6

Time to de-mould your creation! Once you have taken it out of the mould, it will gain its full strength after 24 hours. Jesmonite needs all the moisture to evaporate to gain its strength.
