Brand name: Azunol Ointment 0.033%

Active ingredient: Dimethyl isopropylazulene

Dosage form: pale blue to pale bluish green ointment

Effects of this medicine

This medicine has anti-inflammatory action and helps to heal wounds. It also has anti-allergic action.

It is usually used in the treatment of eczema, dermal erosion and ulcer due to burn and other diseases.

The following patients may need to be careful when using this medicine. Be sure to tell your doctor and pharmacist.

- If you have previously experienced any allergic reactions (itch, rash etc.) to any medicines or foods.
- If you are pregnant or breastfeeding.
- If you are taking any other medicinal products. (Some medicines may interact to enhance or diminish medicinal effects. Beware of over-the-counter medicines and dietary supplements as well as other prescription medicines.)

Dosing schedule (How to take this medicine)

- Your dosing schedule prescribed by your doctor is((to be written by a healthcare professional))
- In general, apply adequate amount of the medicine...Strictly follow the instructions.
- Do not use the medicine as an ophthalmic preparation. If the medicine gets into the eye, wash away with water. If you notice any abnormality, consult with your doctor/pharmacist immediately.
- If you miss a dose, use a dose as soon as possible. You should not take two doses at one time.
- If you accidentally use more than your prescribed dose, consult with your doctor or pharmacist.
- Do not stop using the medicine without the instructions of your doctor.

Precautions while taking this medicine

- Since the base of the medicine is derived from natural ingredients, it varies in color and hardness individually. Some ointment liquefies, however, it does not influence on its therapeutic effect.

Possible adverse reactions to this medicine

The most commonly reported adverse reactions include glow, itch, hypersensitivities such as dermal irritation and rash, eruption of skin, blister (contact dermatitis). If any of these symptoms occur consult with your doctor or pharmacist.

The symptoms described below are rarely seen as initial symptoms of the adverse reactions indicated in brackets. If any of these symptoms occur, stop taking this medicine and see your doctor immediately.

The above symptoms do not describe all the adverse reactions to this medicine. Consult with your doctor or pharmacist if you notice any symptoms of concern other than those listed above.

Storage conditions and other information

- Keep out of the reach of children. Store away from direct sunlight, heat and moisture.
- Discard the remainder. Do not store them. If you do not know how to dispose of it, please consult the pharmacy or medical institution where you received it. Please do not give it to others.
